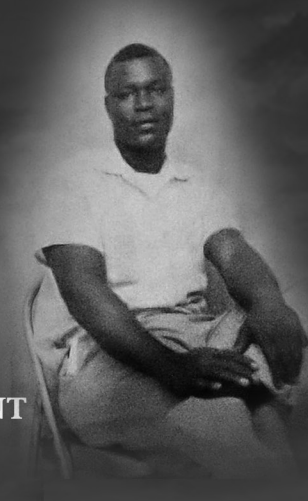

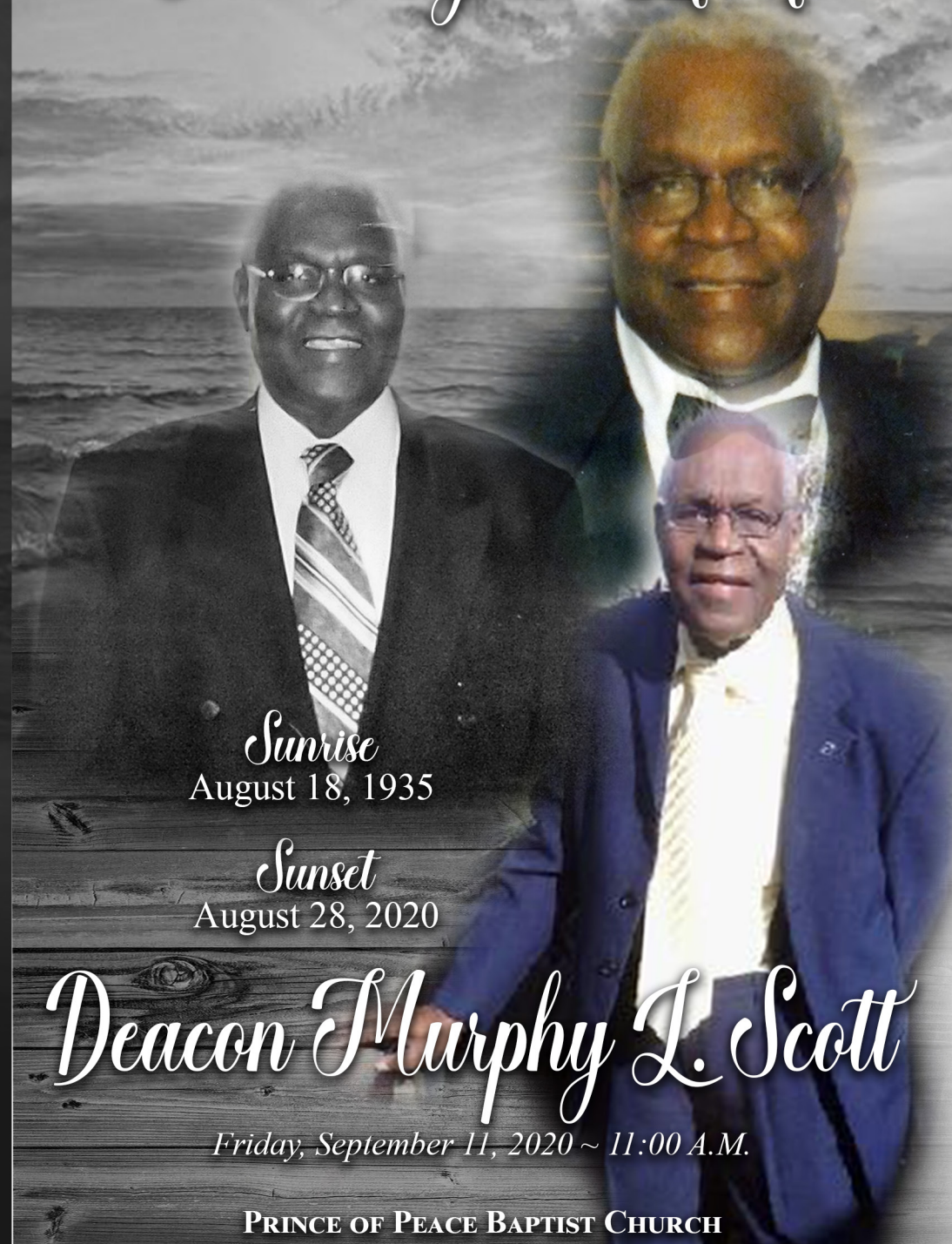

Murphy Lee Scott was born in Callahan Florida to the late Blossom and Willie Scott on August 18, 1935. He was raised by his Grandparents, Willie and Lena Atwaters, in Camden County (Silco Community) after the death of his mother. He attended Harris Memorial School in Silco.

Murphy met and married Almeter Alberty Scott on March 26, 1955 and from this union they had five children: Harvey, Murphy Jr., Richard, Debra, Angela. In 1972 they parted ways and Murphy had already move to the Hollywood area. He met and married Doris Shuler Scott on March 15, 1973. From this union they had one child: Kim Scott.

Murphy worked as a Construction Worker for many years at Stevens Construction Company in West Palm Beach, Florida before moving to Hollywood. After his move, he worked for American Engineering as a Machinist until he retired.

He was a faithful worker in the various churches that he attended where he became Chairman of the Deacon Board, Choir Member, Sunday School Teacher, Van Driver and he worked as a Trustee for his church.

Murphy was one of the Founding Members of Believers of Christ Ministries where he served as the Chairman of The Deacon board and was instrumental in Building the ministry for 23 years, until he was unable to attend. But it did not stop him from serving God from his bed. He was a Powerful Prayer Warrior and did not mine praying for people over the phone. He Loved God, His Family, and His Pastor very much. Murphy went home to be with the Lord on August 28, 2020, shortly after the passing of his wife Doris Scott of 47 years.
