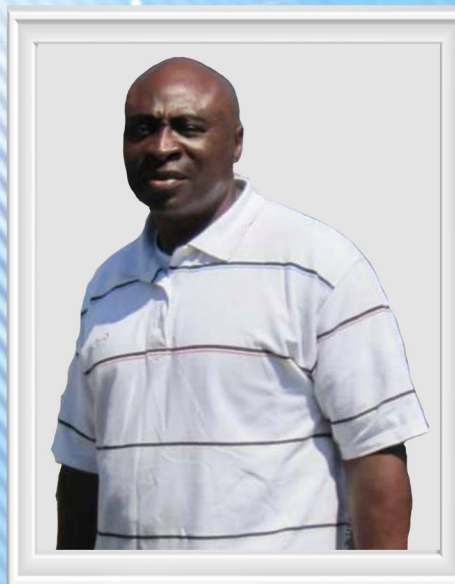
## *My Best Friend*

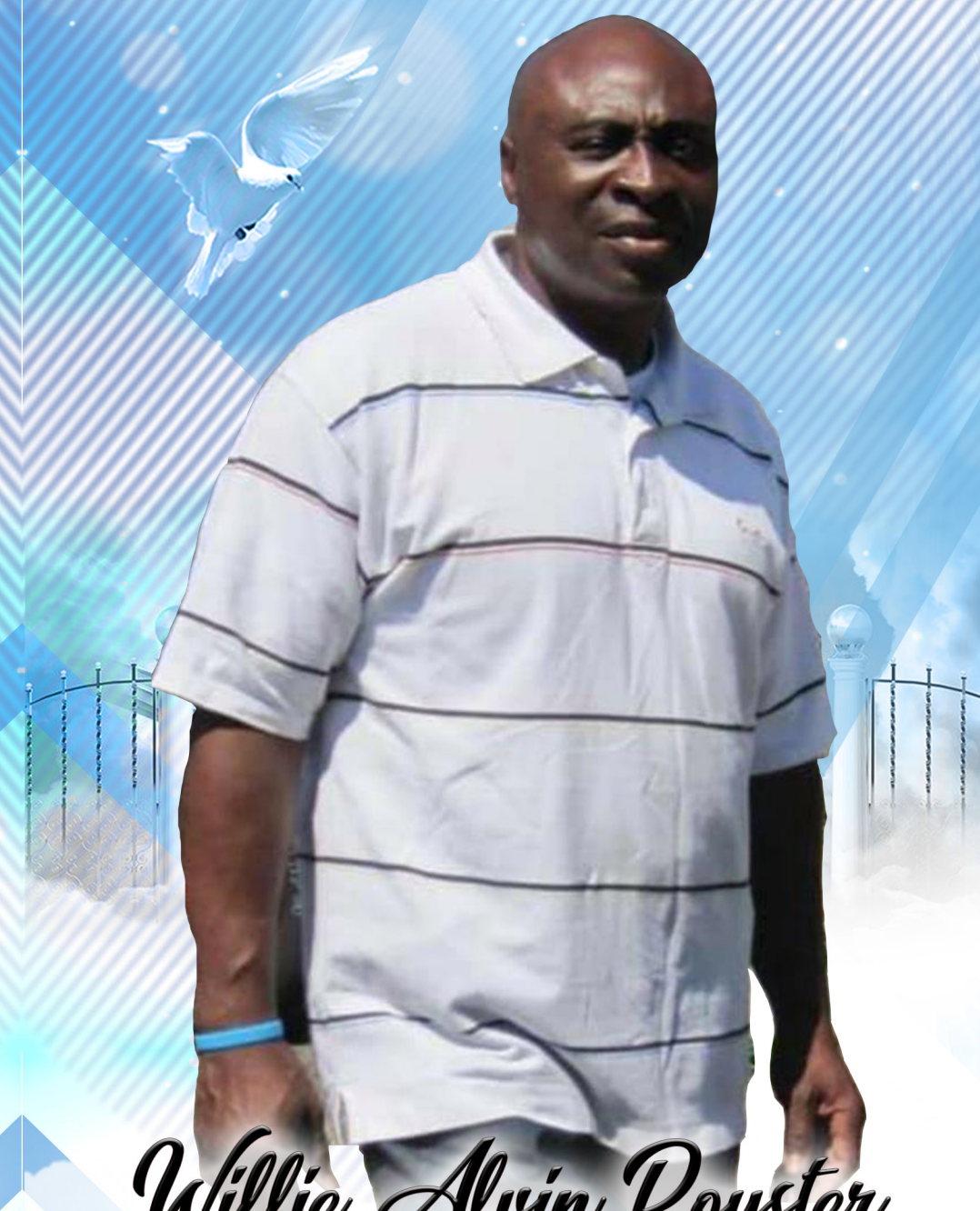
