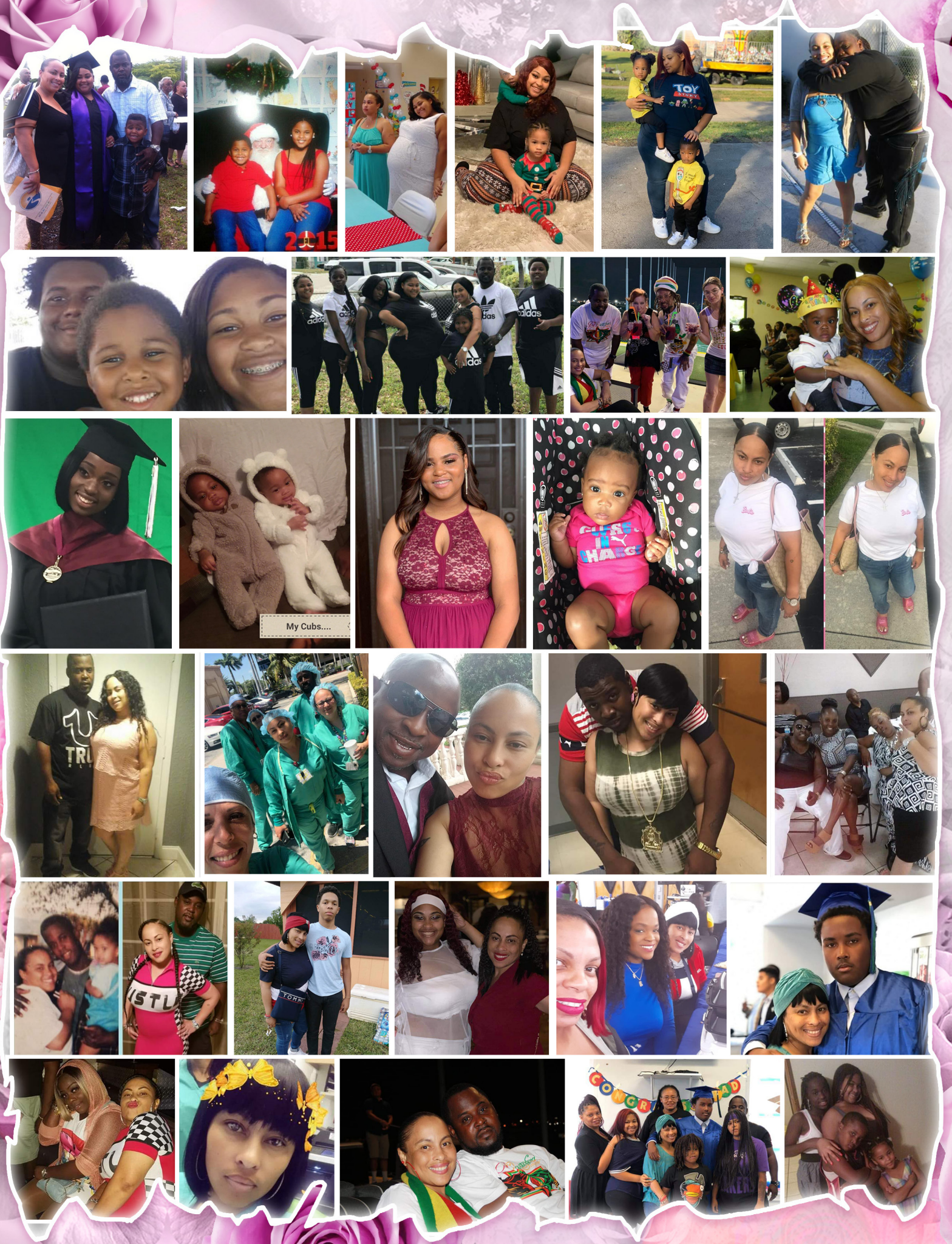

And took me by the hand*

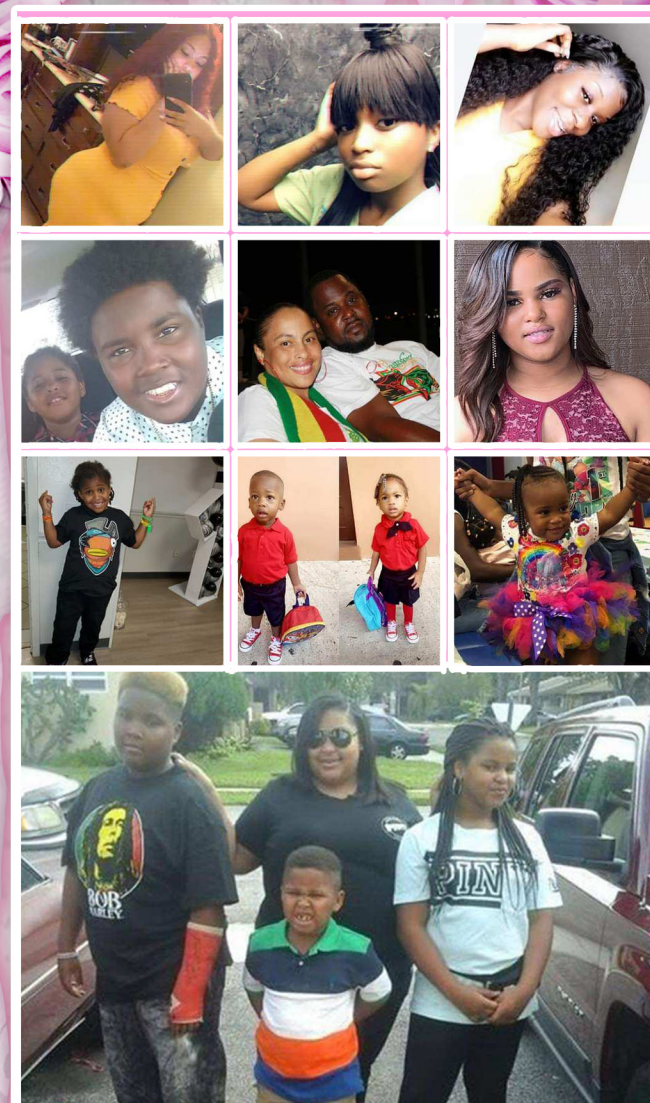
*The angel said my place was ready
