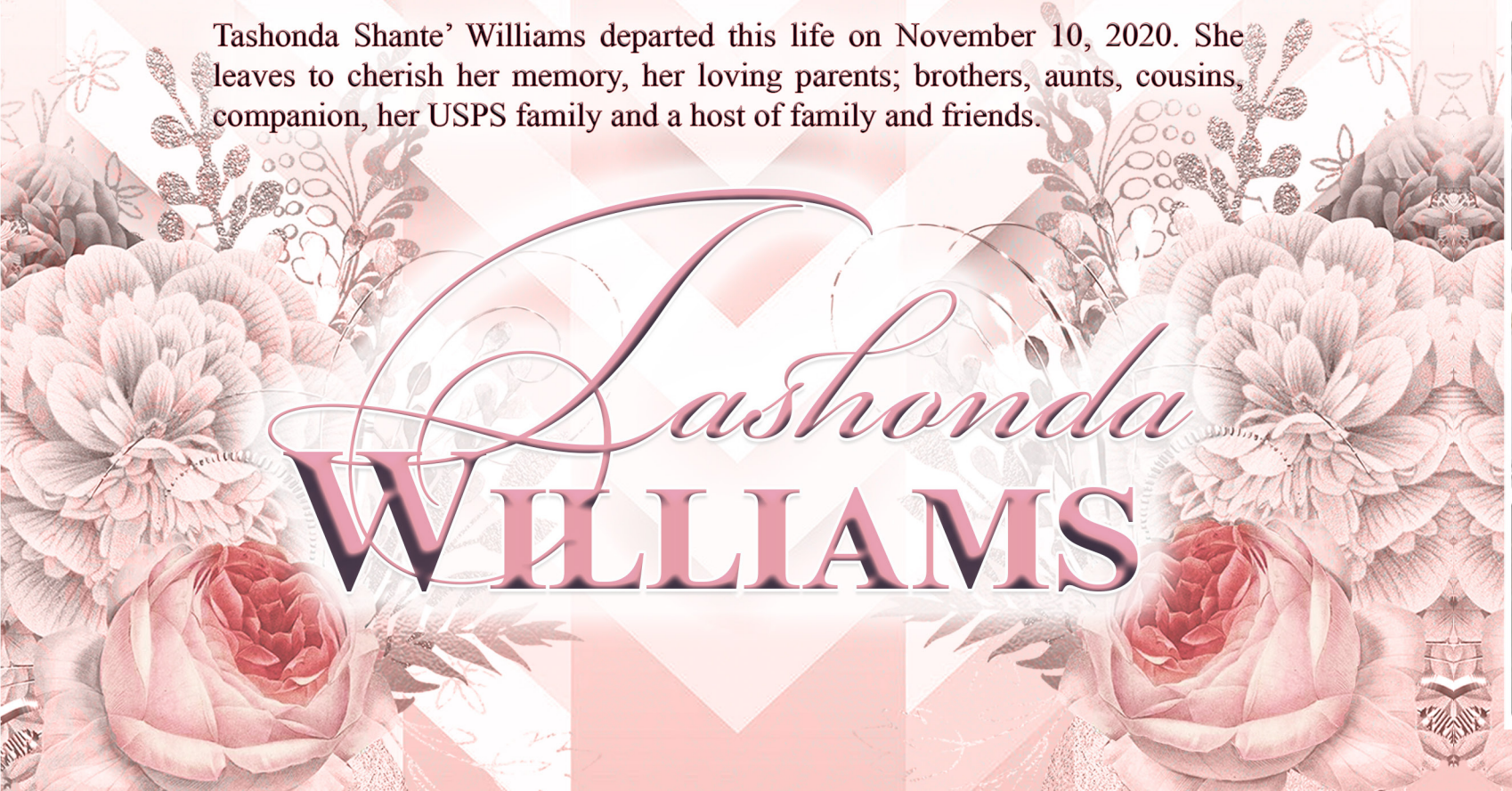
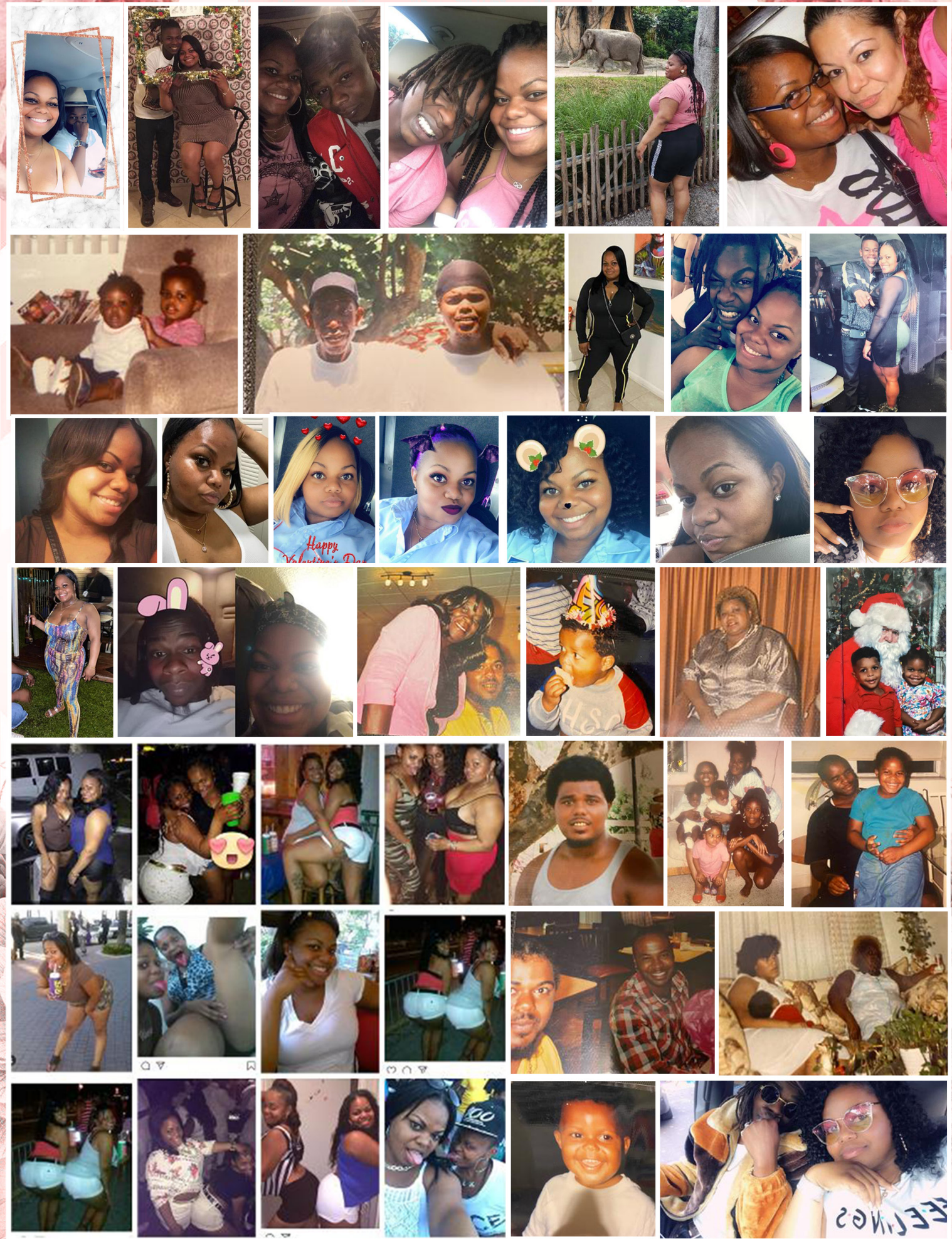
A Celebration of a BEAUTIFUL LIFE WELL LIVED

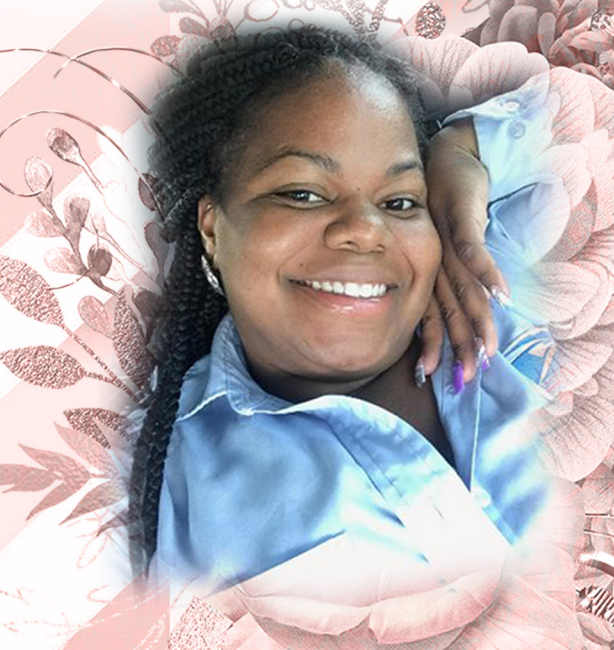
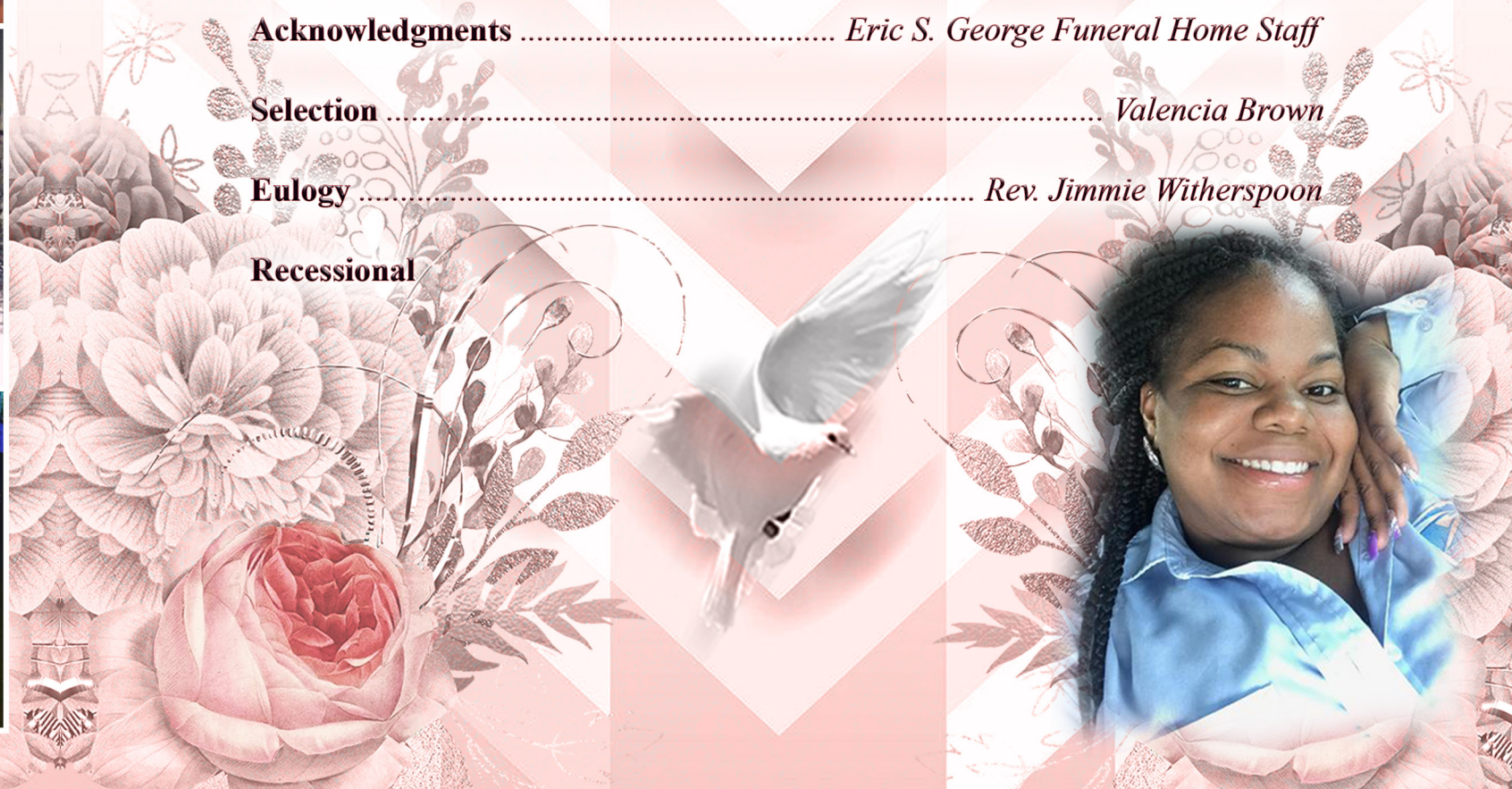
