# Life Reflections

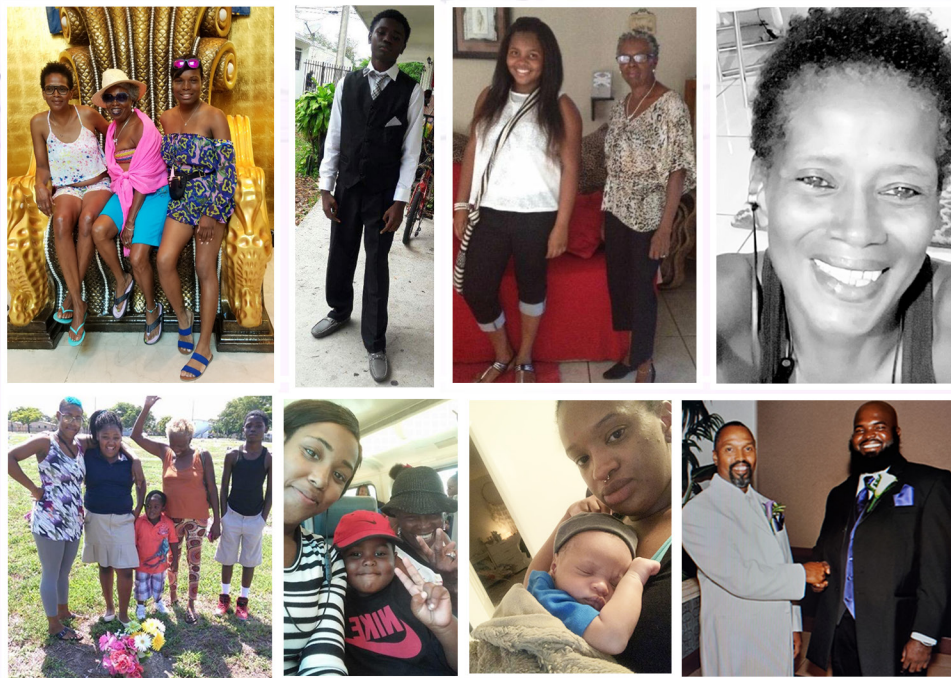
