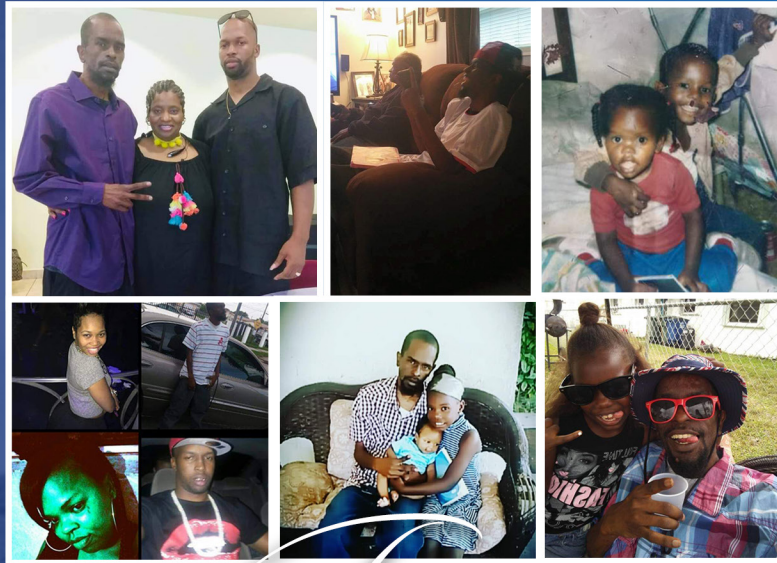
Markie was raised in the City of Hallandale Beach. He was educated in the Broward County School System and attended Hallandale High School.
