Rosette received her formal education in Seamstress/First Aid in Tech School, Haiti.

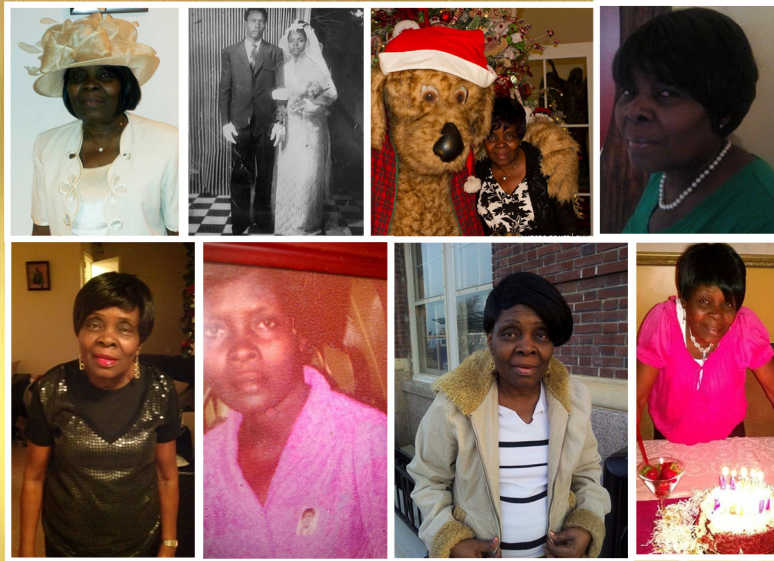

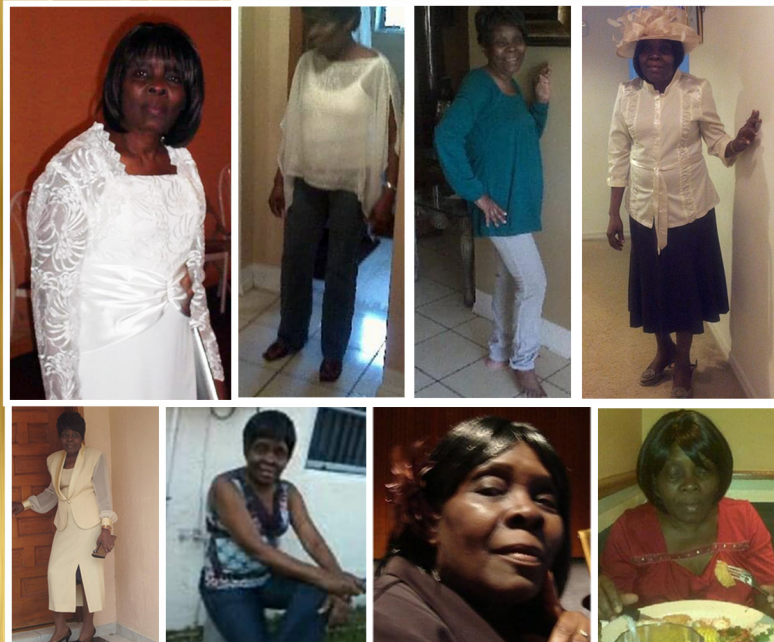
She was self-employed and worked from home.
