Simone K. Griffiths was born on April 28, 1982 to the union of Marnis and Vernal Griffiths in Kingston, Jamaica.

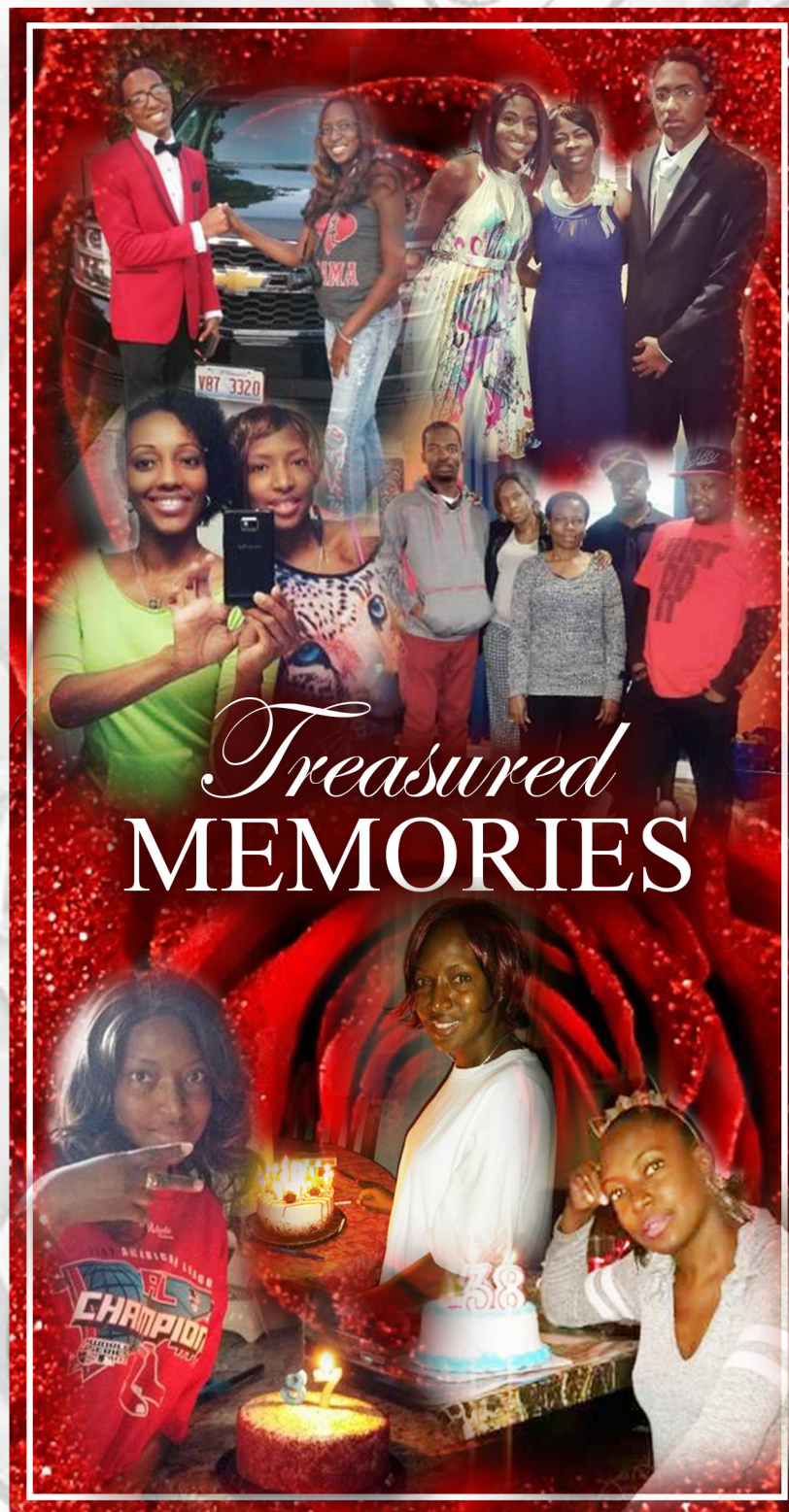
Simone received her formal education at Hallandale High School in Hallandale, Florida. She furthered her education Florida Career College in Miami, Florida and later became a Massage Therapist.
