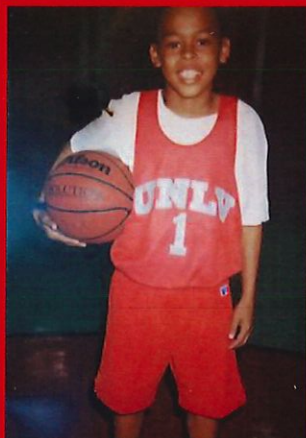
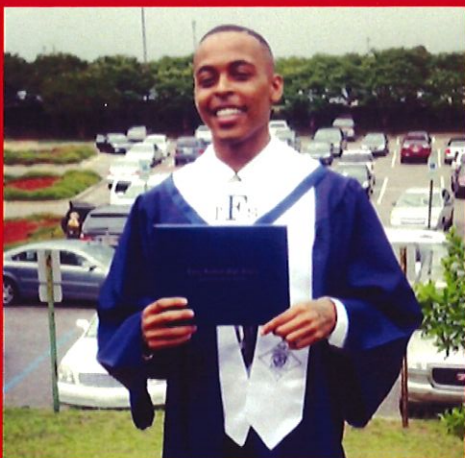
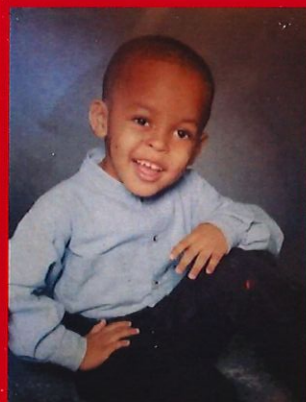


Leave It All To God

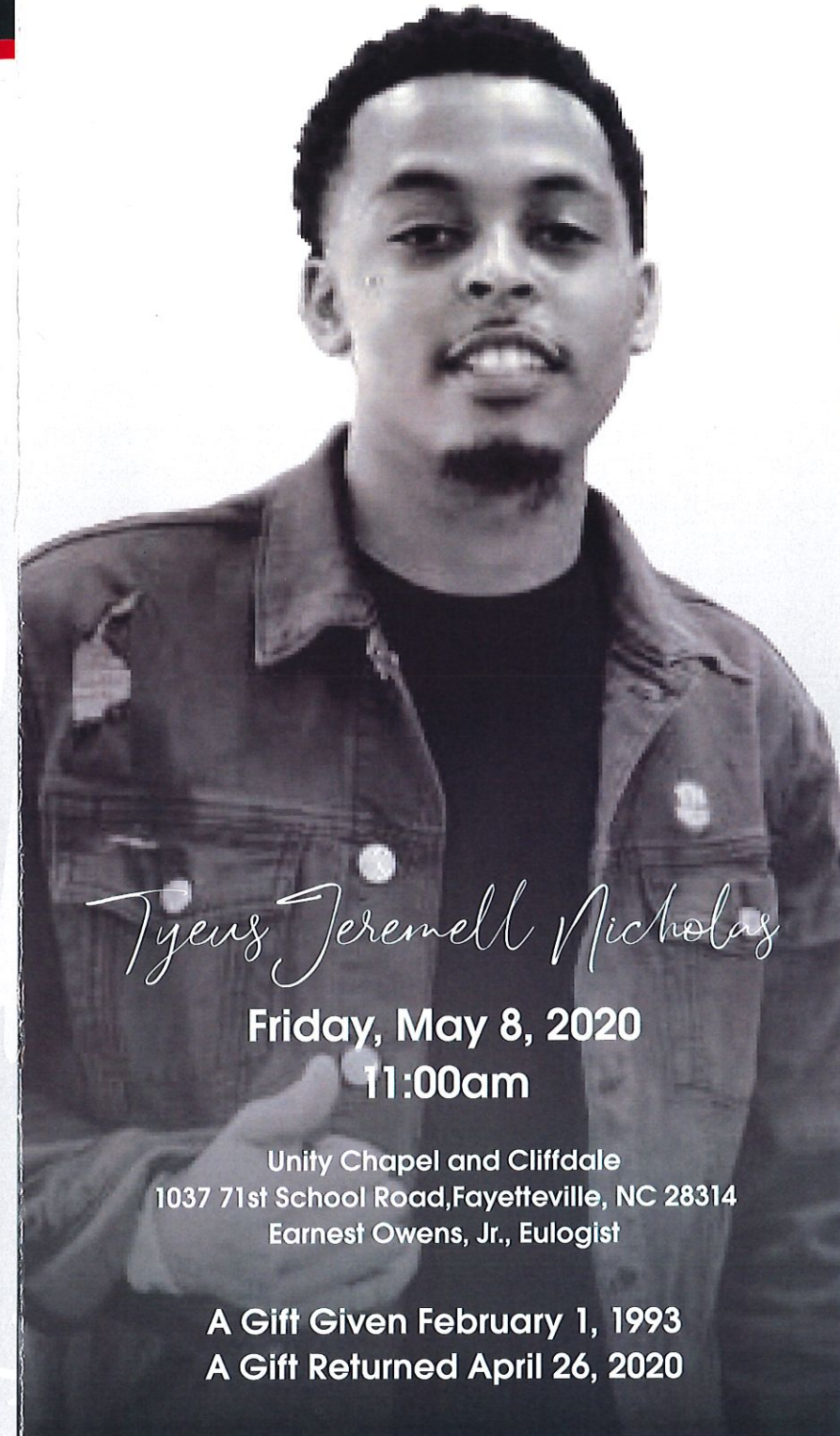
