In faith each spring he planted the seeds, in hope to recap his family's needs. With patience he waited for the harvest to come, to gather the fruits of his labour done.

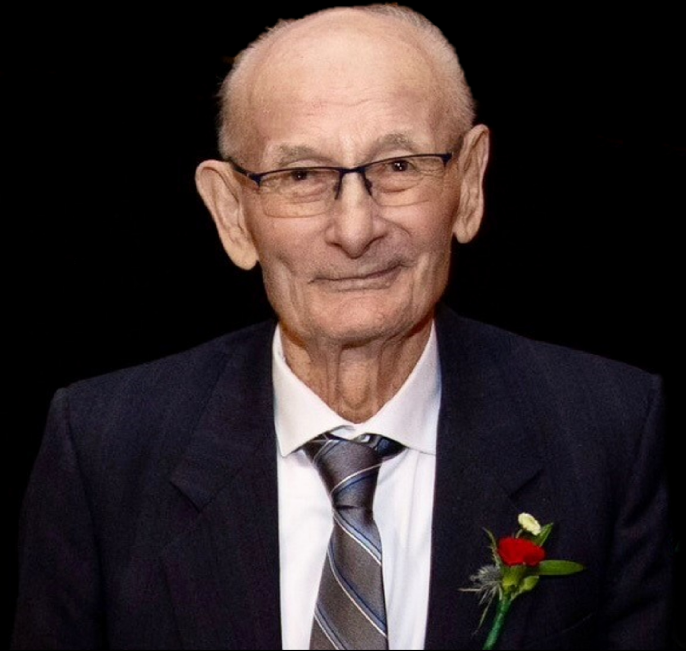
Ever turning seasons, the years sped fast, 'til the final harvest came at last. Then claim anew by beloved sod, He was gathered home to be with God.
