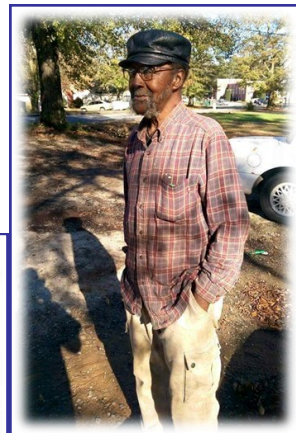
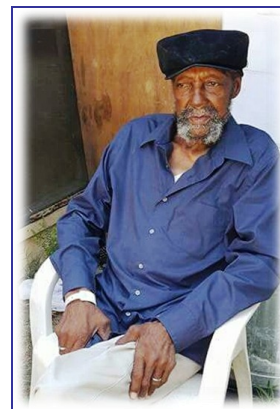
He departed this earthly life to go from labor to reward on Monday, September 19, 2016 at Piedmont Fayette Hospital, Fayetteville, GA.
