The Life Story

Sanders Belvin Jr., affectionately known as "Pig" was born on January 2, 1935, in Houston County, Georgia to the late Mr. Sanders Belvin Sr. and Mrs. Abbie Lane Belvin.

He attended and graduated High School from Flint River Farms School in Macon County Georgia. In the South, during his childhood, he worked on the family farm cultivating crops from dawn to dust. He met Brydie Lee Mobley Belvin in grammar school, and in 1957 they married. In 1965, they migrated to the North to create better opportunities for themselves and their family where they made the Bronx, N.Y. their home.

Sanders held numerous jobs over the course of his life. In fact, he worked for a Rock Quarry, a Printing Company, was a Heavy Equipment Operator, and as a Professional Painter prior to finding his calling as a Master Plumber. He worked for Uberstein Plumbing Company for many years before establishing his own business, Van B Plumbing, Inc., where he employed many people, including family members.
