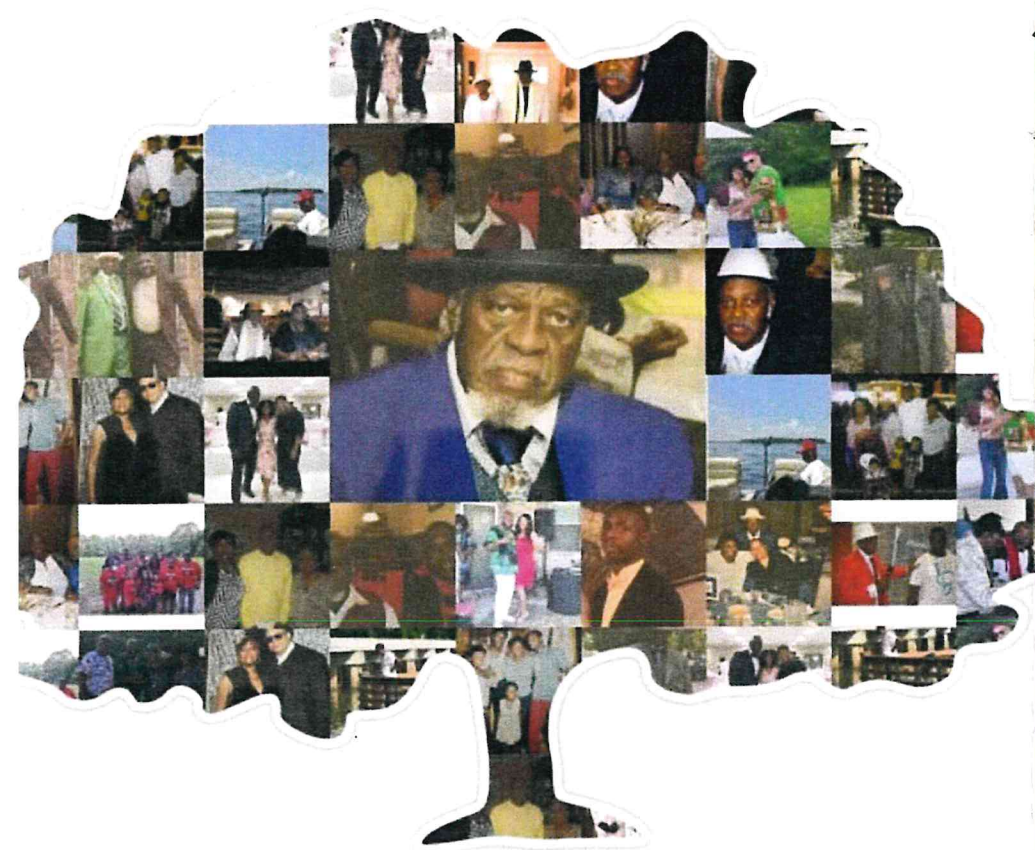
## Obituary
