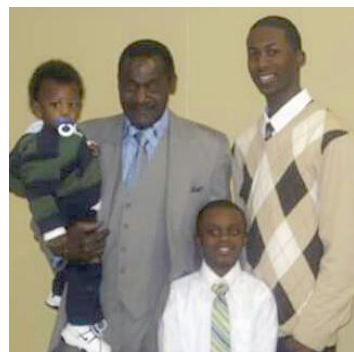
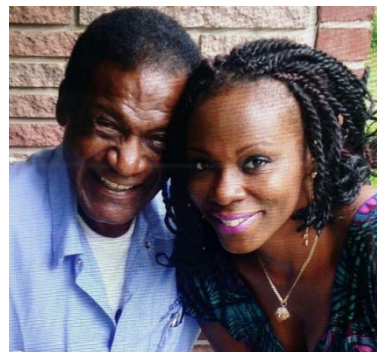

but unto all them also that love his appearing.*

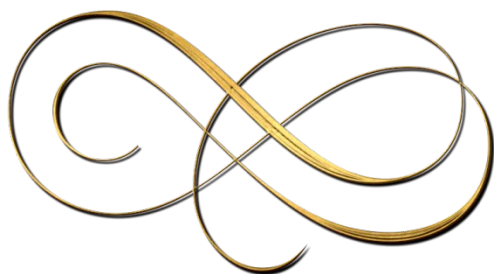
