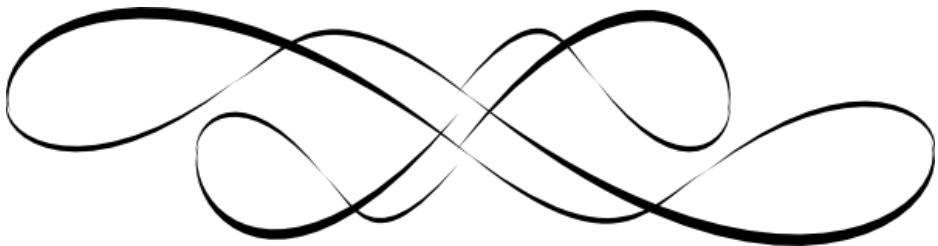
LIFE’S REFLECTION
