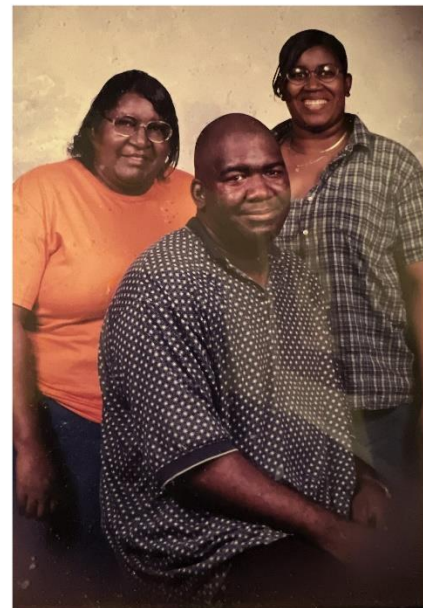




### When God Called Her Home
