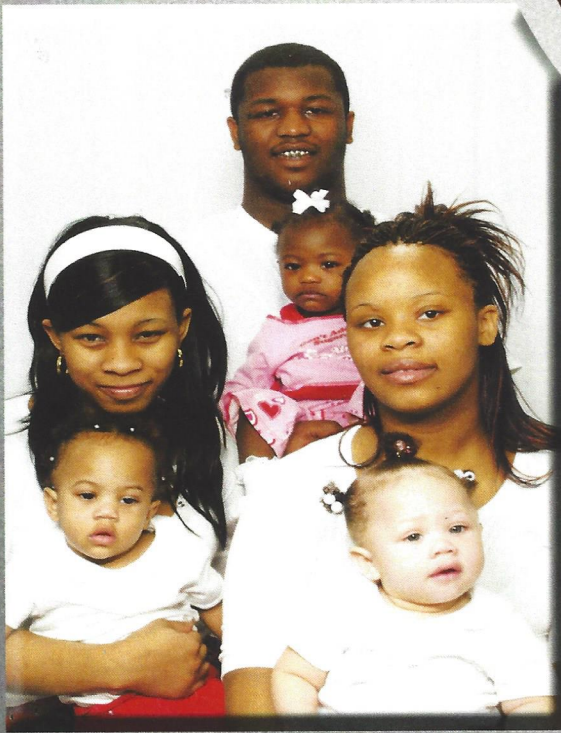
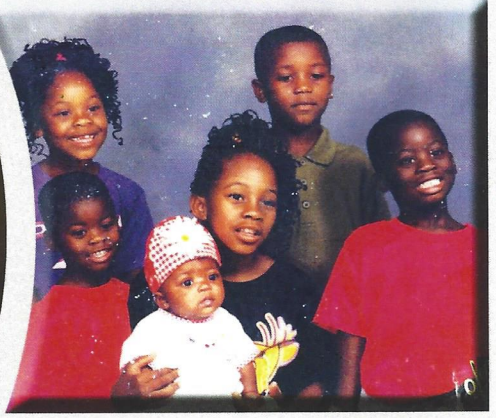
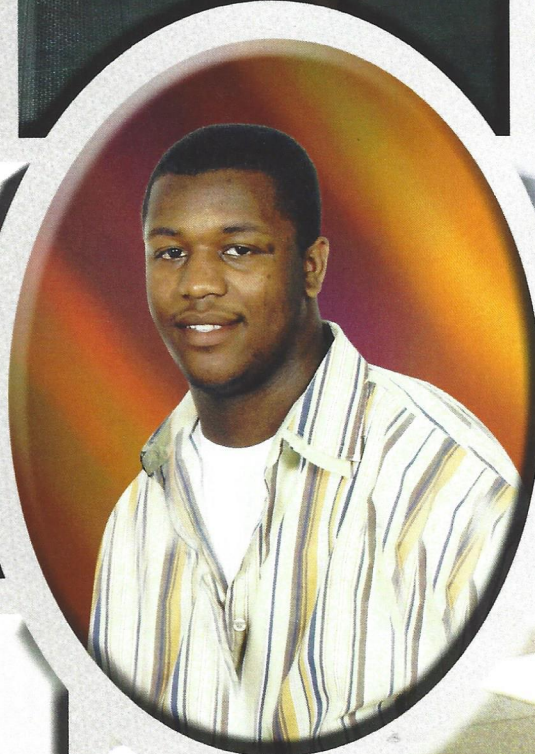
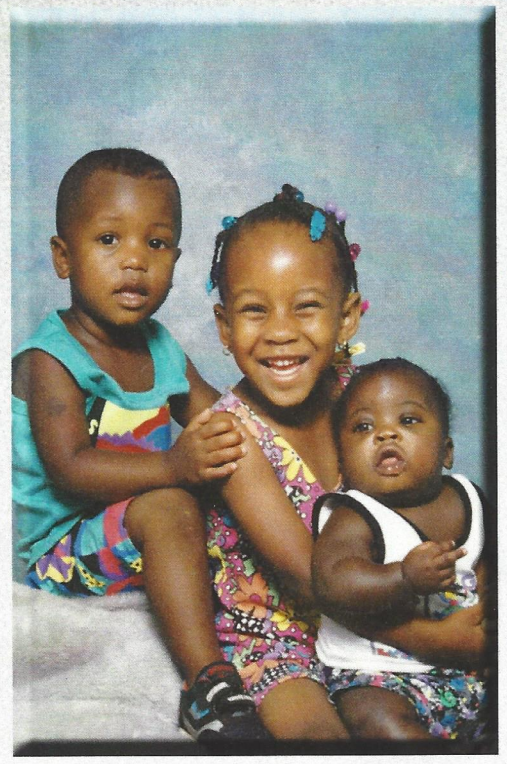
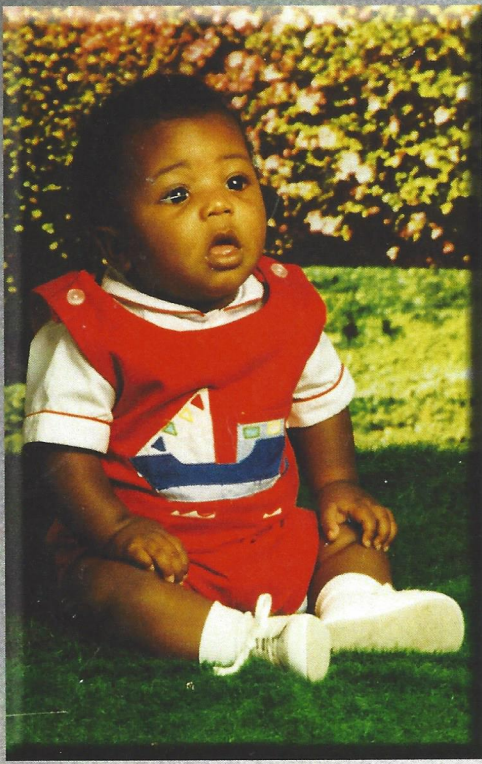
You never said I'm leaving,

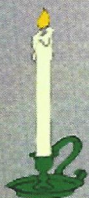
