



Remember Me

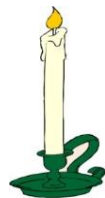
*Remember me with smiles not tears

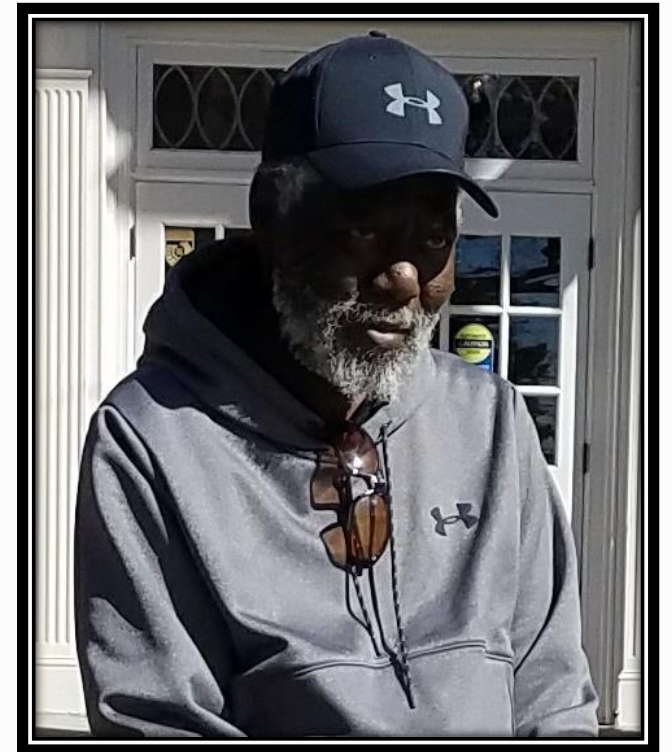

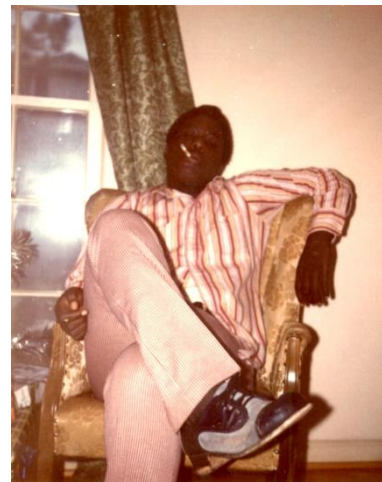
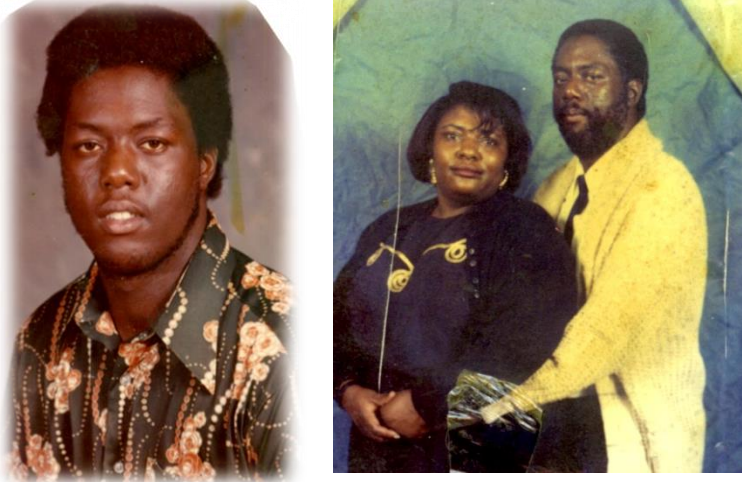
