



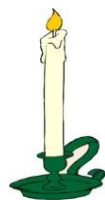
*No farewell words were spoken

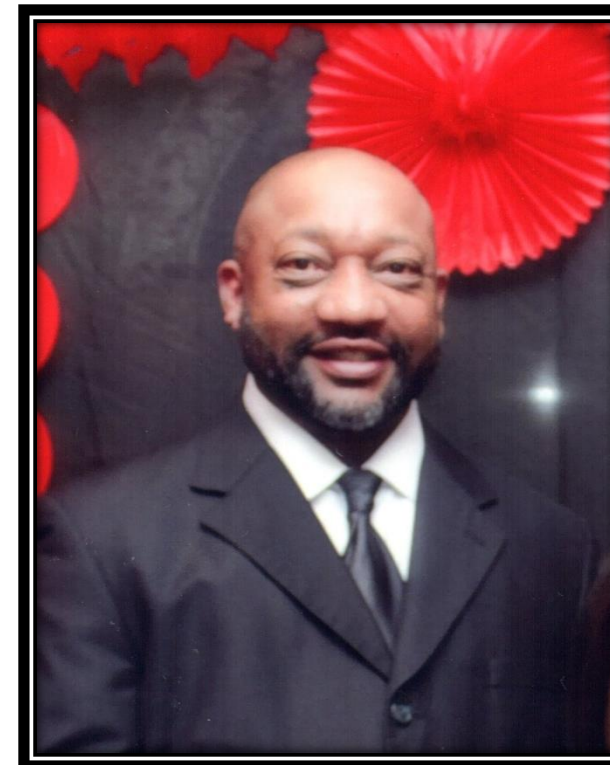
