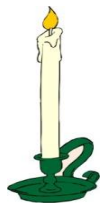

Smile, open your eyes, love and go on.*

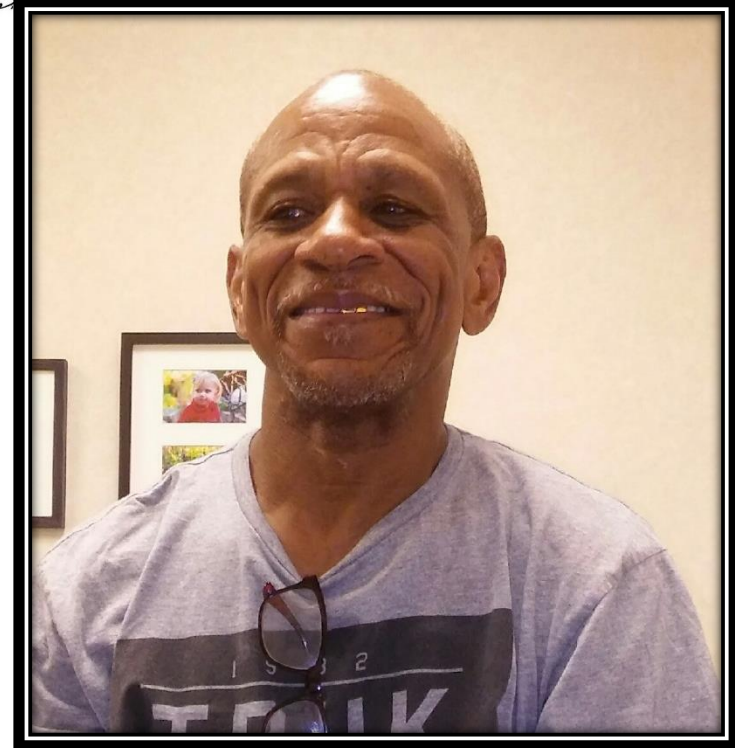
