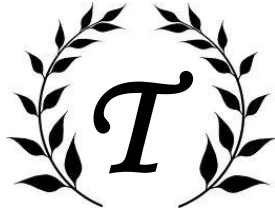

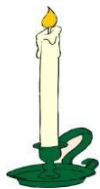

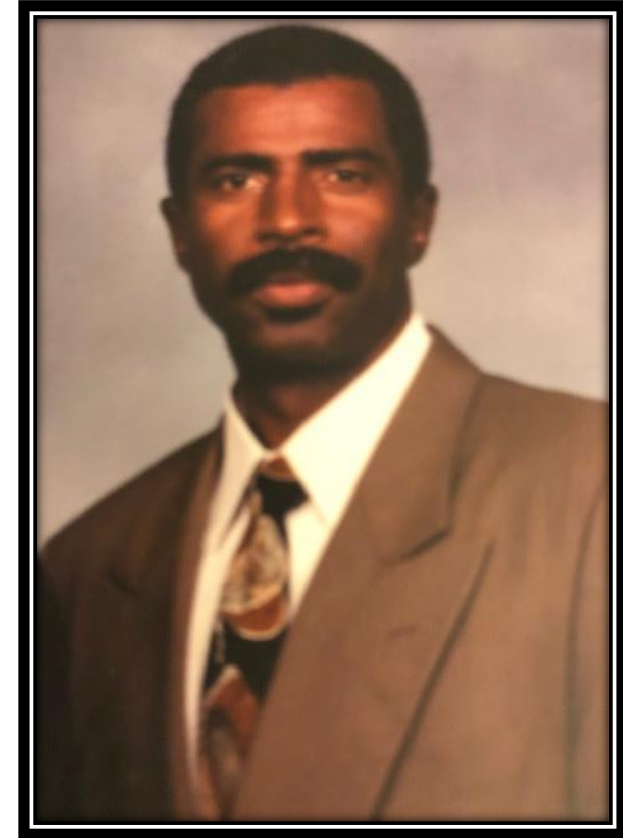

## Obituary

**William Randolph Thompson**, was born September 10, 1952 and departed his earthly life on November 17, 2018 in an atmosphere of love.

Randolph (also known as "Thomp" by his friends, and "Ran" by his family) was the son of Leonard and Robbie Bolden Thompson. He was educated in the Williamston public schools graduating from Palmetto High School in 1970. His appreciation for hands-on trades led him to later take courses at both Greenville Tech and Midlands Technical College. He was a United States Army Veteran and self-taught electrician with a knack for taking things apart and putting them back together again.

Randolph was our family's rock; in our eyes he was a strong minded, and courageous person. Though small in stature, he was a giant of a man. He was selfless, quiet and somewhat a loner at times, however, there was no doubt that family was his heart. His nieces and nephews were like his own children. His soul always smiled when he saw them. His siblings knew he was the "boss" and he practiced at making them acknowledge his role. Their bond was undeniable. He has lived, laughed, and learned to dance to the beat of his own drum. We, his family were blessed to have had him in our lives; we love him deeply and though he will live on in our hearts, he will forever be missed.
