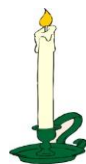

My Son

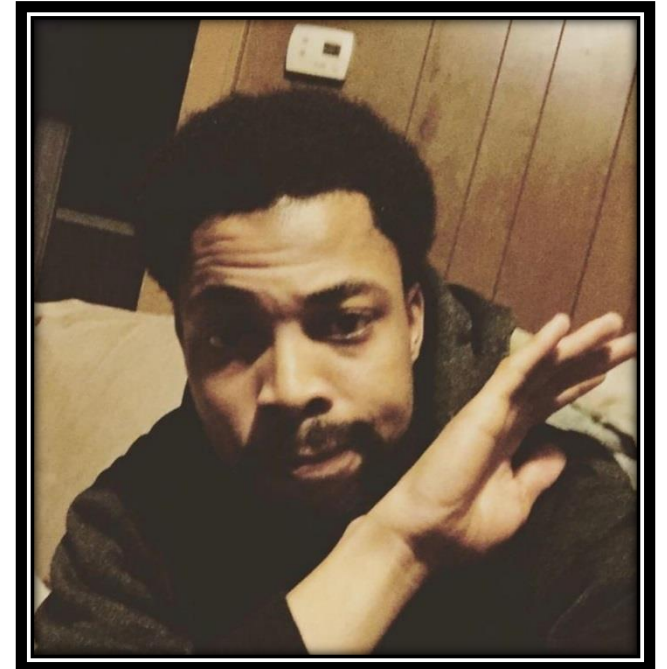
*It broke my heart to lose you,

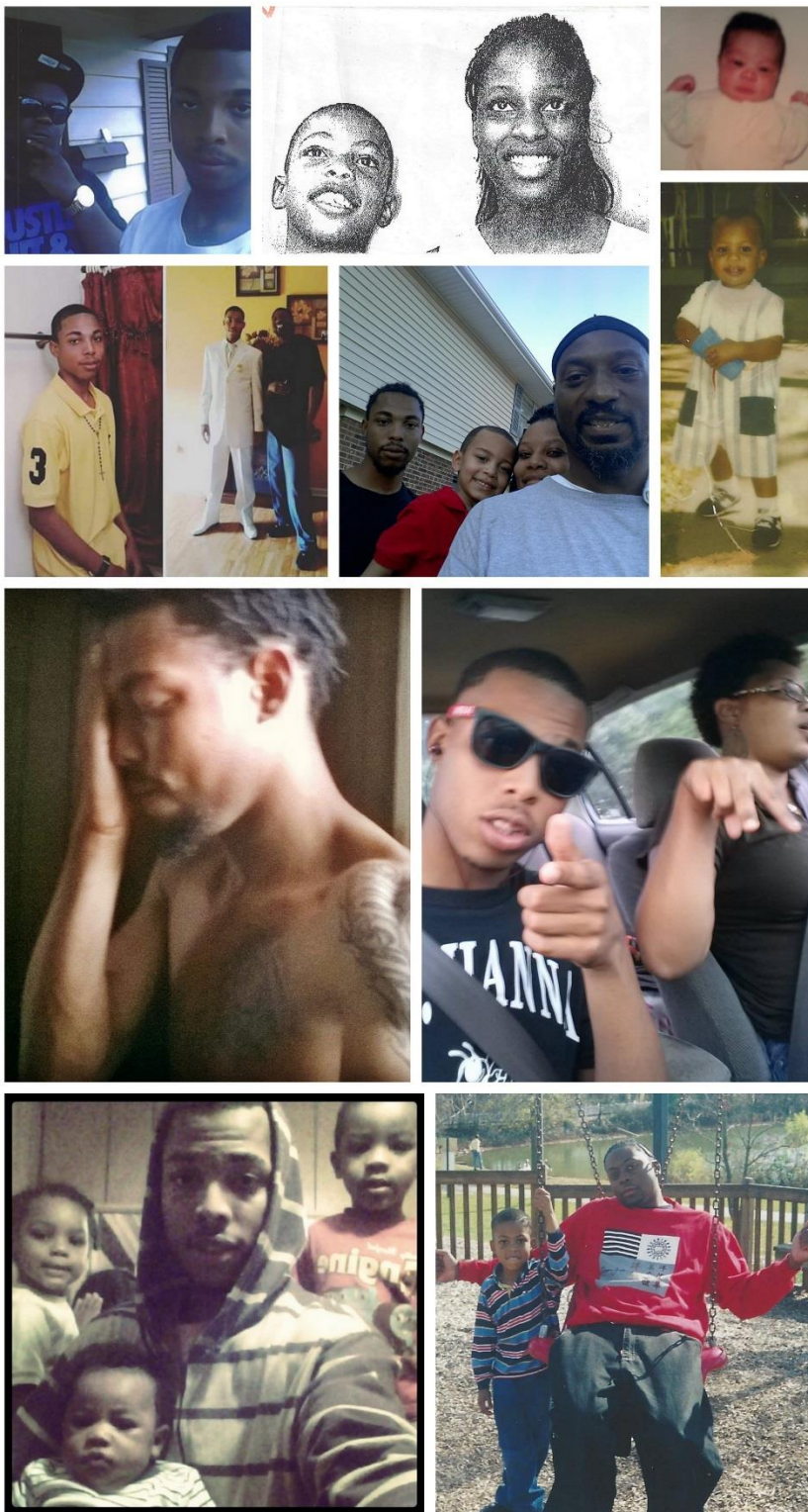
