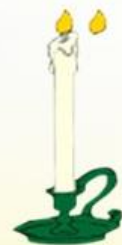

He joined Mt. Able Baptist Church located in Pendleton, SC at the age of six. After joining Mt. Able at a young age, Eric and his brothers began ministering through music which inspired many generations. Eric graduated from T.L. Hanna High School in 1985. He furthered his education at Morris Brown College located in Atlanta, GA. After attending Morris Brown, he later attended North Greenville College located in Tigerville, SC, where he started the North Greenville College Choir. Eric also later received two degrees from Temple University. He was ordained as a Minister and as a Minister of Music. While pursuing his musical career, he became a radio host for WIMG 1300 AM located in Trenton, New Jersey and later became the Minister of Music for Shalom Baptist church in Philadelphia, PA. Eric has played for many influential gospel recording artists, such as: Yolanda Adams, Stephanie Mills, Tamela Mann, David Mann, as well as many others. He has received numerous awards and accolades across the world for his ministry in music. Eric was best known for his recording albums, "Build Me A Mansion" and "If My People".
