The words, "Thank you for all of your help," seem very inadequate when said to a person who has helped a member of your family through a heart attack. Perhaps by saying it in an open letter

it will make those words mean more.

On June 25 my 38 year old brother, David, suffered a heart attack and was taken to Sioux Valley Hospital. As soon as his family doctor, Dr. Larry Sittner, had made the diagnosis of the attack he called in Dr. Tom Burkhart, but in the two weeks that David was hospitalized we became great admirers of his. Dr. Burkhart visited David 2 or 3 times a day the first week and at least once a day after that. As busy as he was he never left the coronary care area without checking the waiting rooms to talk to our family and give us a report on David's condition. There were times that he spent 15 or 20 minutes with us explaining things and answering our "stupid" questions. He would tell us to stop him if we didn't understand something and he'd explain it again.

I'm sure there were other families in the coronary unit who really envied us because we had a doctor who was concerned not only about his patient, but also about the family who were sitting

waiting, wondering and worrying.

Are the Dr. Burkharts a one-in-a-million? I hope not, but if so, I'm awfully glad we got to know this one.

Once again, thank you for all of your help, Dr. Burhart! Thanks, too, to your family for having to sacrifice time with you so that you can help so many others.
