

## Life Profile of Reverend Cecil V. Clement

Reverend Cecil V. Clement, 75, husband of Geneva Jones Clement (married 44 years), departed this life on Sunday, September 1, 2019, at AnMed Health Medical Center. Born in Belton, SC, he was the son of Booker T. and Felicia Clinkscales Clement. Rev Clement was a graduate of Geer-Gantt High School (1962) and later received a Bachelor's Degree from Benedict College (1966). For many years he taught Language Arts in the Greenwood County public schools; however, his teaching career was interrupted after being drafted into military services for three years where he served as a medic in the United States Army (stationed in South Korea). He later went to work at Badische Corp., which later became known as BASF, as a long-distance truck driver (traveling the United States and Canada) and received numerous accolades and awards for safe driving. After twenty-five years as a truck driver he retired. After retirement he later worked in security with Guardsmark and American Security and served as a shift supervisor of security at Greenville Memorial Hospital.

Reverend Clement began working in the ministry at Mt. Zion Baptist Church under the guidance of Dr. E.F Mathis where he received his certificate to preach in 1979.
