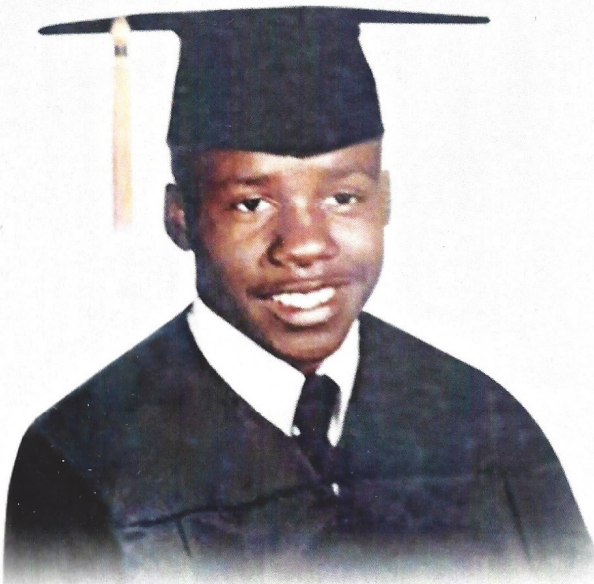
Honoring Willie's Life
