His loving companion was Sharon Kirland Cowley and they had five children.

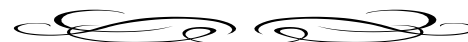
He was preceded in death by his grandparents, Willie Mina and Leroy Cowley, Sr., and James Powell.
