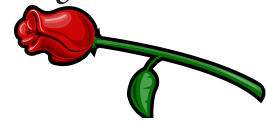


## To My Sweet Mama

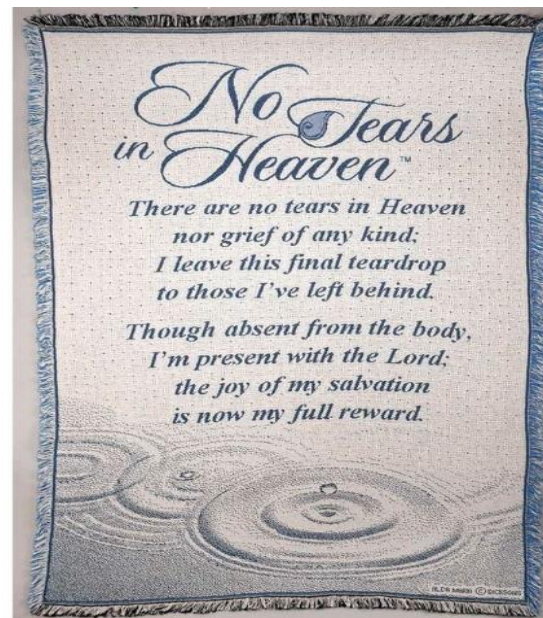
