My huckleberry friend, moon river and me

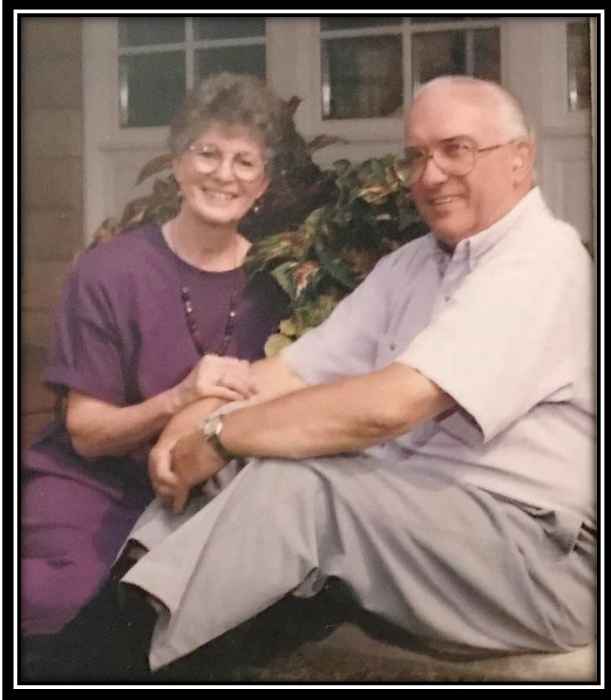
