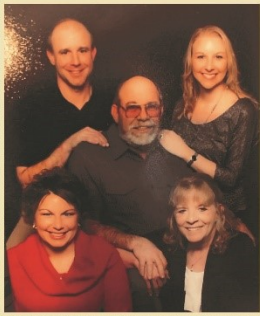


GOD'S GARDEN

The day God called you home.

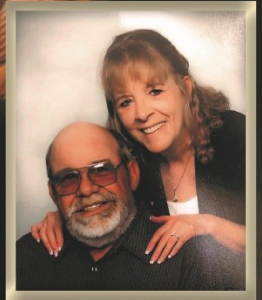
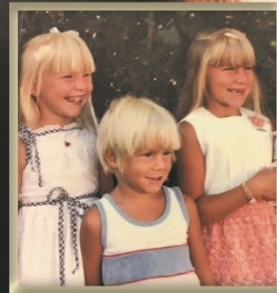
