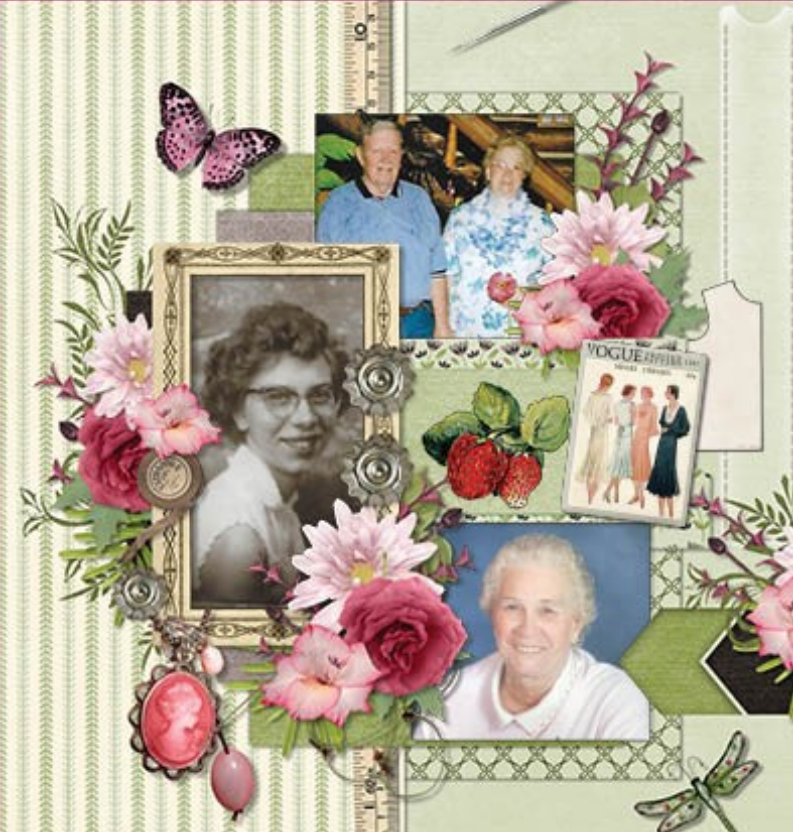
**To Those Whom I Love
