



A SILENT TEAR

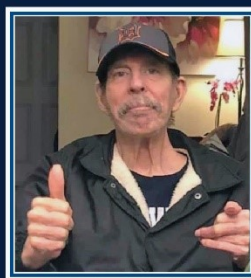
Just close your eyes and you will see

Joe retired from TRW in Portland, Michigan. Joe was a graduate of Lakewood High School class of 1969.

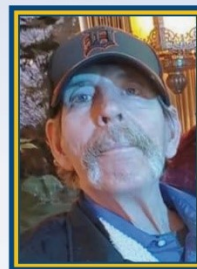
He enjoyed playing pool, golfing, and spending time with his family and friends.
