He married Angela Williams Scott, and they raised five kids. In his spare time, he enjoyed spending quality time with his family and playing electronic games.

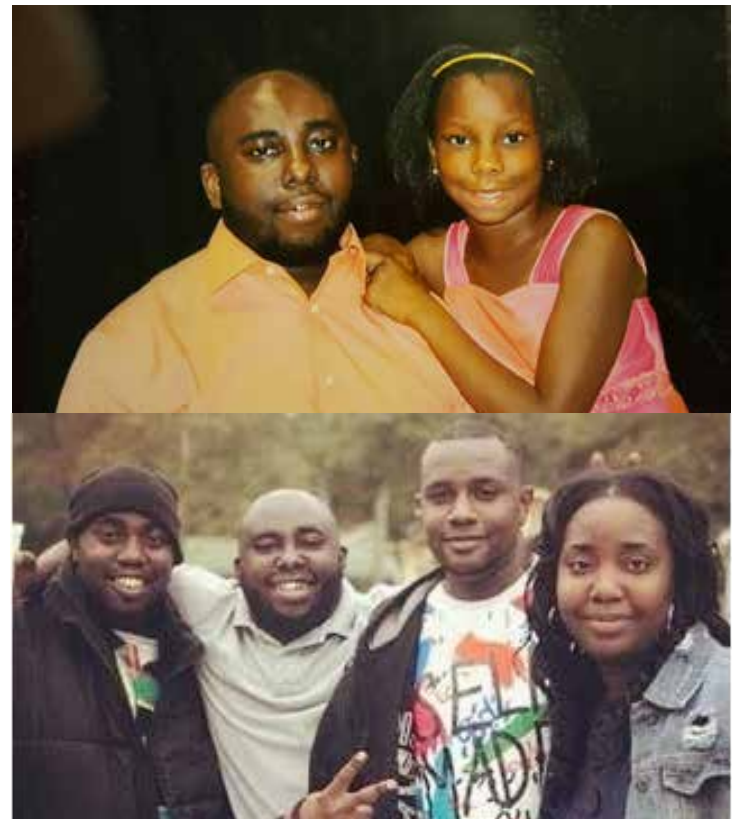
