As a child, Ehis (which is his nickname) was a very outgoing, vibrant, and energetic little boy. He always enjoyed playing and spending time with his family. Ehis also loved to sing, he would sing when he showered, completed homework, and when he was alone in his room. He had a truly remarkable voice. Ehiabhi Isaiah Okojie attended The Academy of Saint Matthias the Apostle private school from Pre-Kindergarten to Fifth grade (2006-2011).

He then completed middle school at Turning Point Academy charter school for sixth through eighth grade (2011-2014). Ehiabhi Isaiah Okojie attended Duval High School in Lanham, MD for ninth grade and completed the rest of his years (10-12th grade) at Charles Herbert Flowers High School in Springdale, MD. Before his passing, he graduated on Saturday, May 30, 2020. Ehiabhi was planning to attend Mount St. Mary's University in August to study Information Technology and later become a Software Engineer.

Ehiabhi Isaiah Okojie went to his glory on Sunday, May 31, 2020 at Children's National Hospital in Washington, D.C. As of now, we have not received the cause of his death.
