Hubert F. Schiro was born on August 14, 1927, to Herbert and Anna (Kaliebe) Schiro in Corvuso. He was baptized on September 9, 1927, and later confirmed at Peace Lutheran Church in Cosmos. Hub attended elementary school in Cosmos and high school in Litchfield.

He enlisted in the Navy and served from September 1945 to August 1946 during the Korean conflict. Hub then served in the Army from September 1950 until September of 1952, when he was honorably discharged.

Hub was united in marriage to Marv (Hogan) Ackerman at Bethel Lutheran church in Willmar on January 2, 1955. Hub lived for his wife. She encouraged him to go hunting, fishing and spend time outdoors. The couple lived in Cosmos, moved to Litchfield in 1967, and to Diamond Lake in 1970. In 1975, they moved to Willmar. Hub and Marv owned and operated Schiro Shoe Repair in Cosmos, Litchfield and Willmar. Hub retired in 1987.

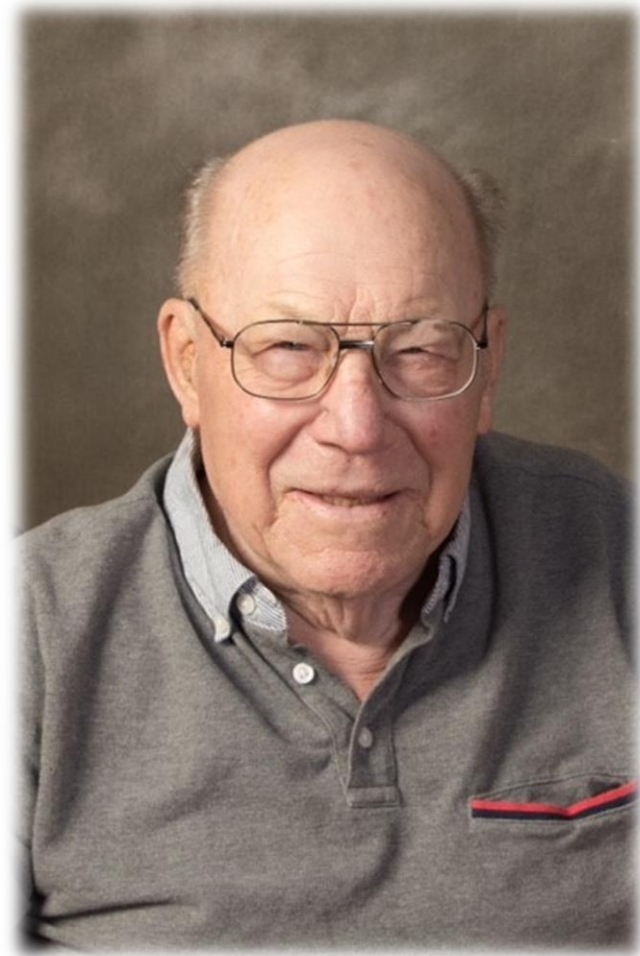
