You gave me life, you gave me love.

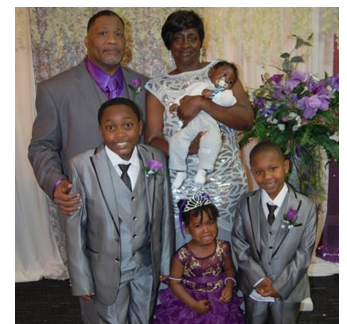
*You left me now, you've gone away.

Between the silence and the tears.

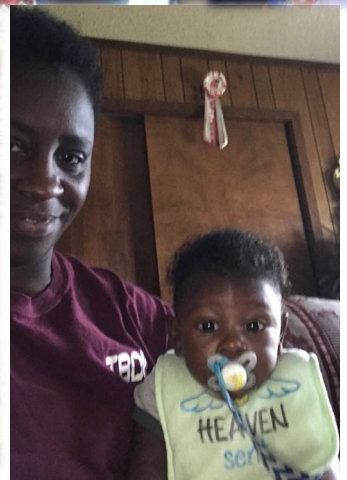
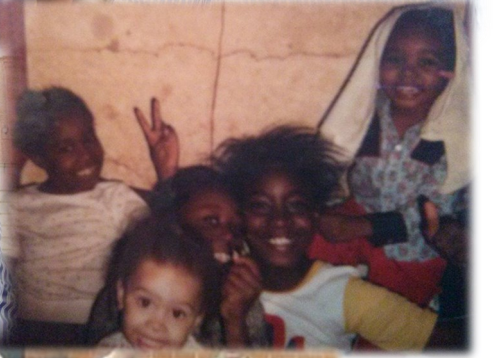
Your memory will not fade away
