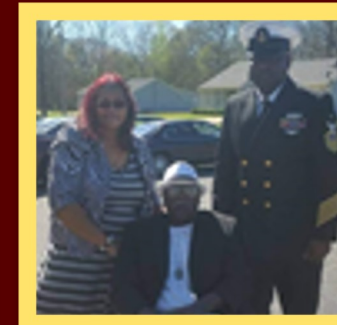
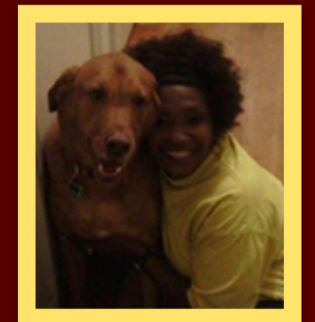
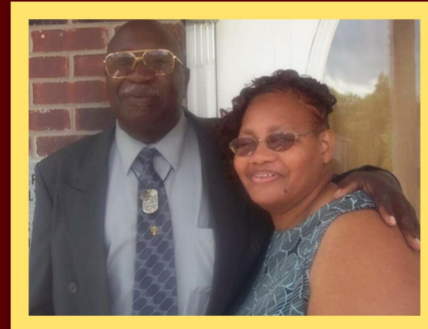
In Memory of My Dear Husband

A Life Well Lived

On Sunday November 29, 2020 at McNairy County Health Care Center in Selmer, TN., the Lord called Mr. Oather Lee Lake to rest after a lengthy illness. He was the first of seven children born on April 28, 1951 to the union of the late Mr. Otha and Bernice Pirtle-Lake in Bolivar, TN.

Mr. Oather Lake attended and graduated from Bolivar Industrial High School. Upon graduating, Mr. Oather moved to St. Louis Missouri. He was drafted into the United States Army in 1970 where he served three years. Mr. Oather later relocated back to Tennessee and attended Whiteville Vocational Technical School. Mr. Oather was honor for the National guard of Tennessee in 1974. He worked as a General Building Trade and Carpentry the year of 1981. He also worked at a shoe factory, build furniture, and worked for Dover Elevator for many years. Mr. Oather was loved and known by many.
