I found my peace... at close of day.*

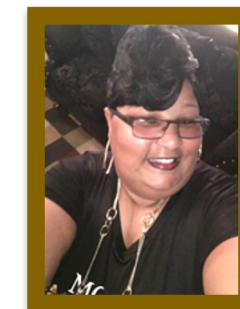
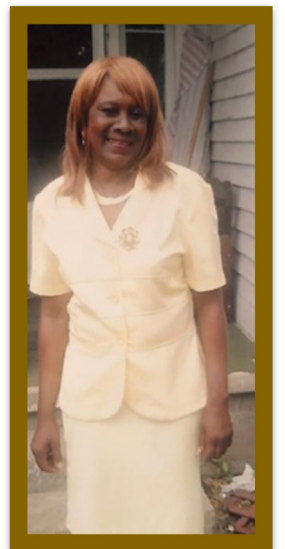
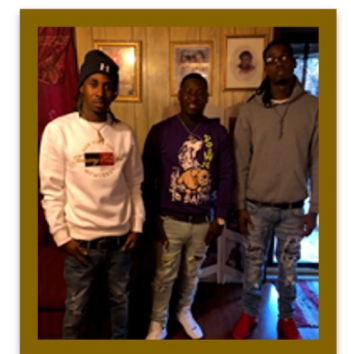
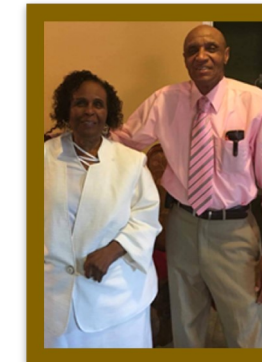
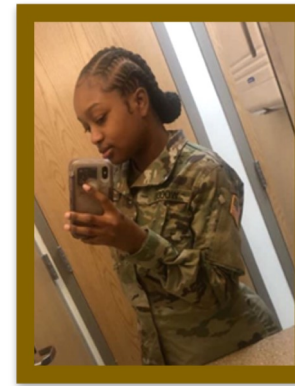
*And if my parting left a void,

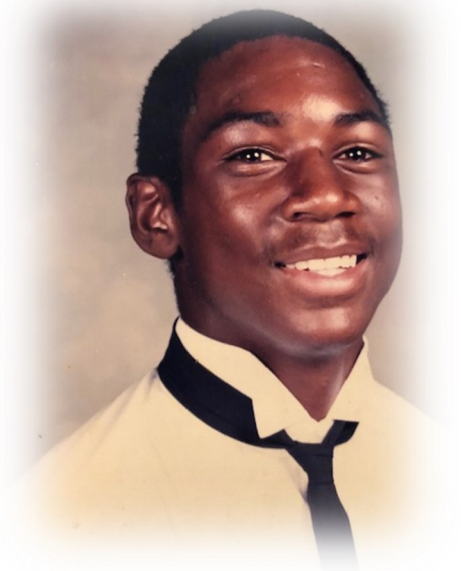


I Miss You Mom
