But I'll always be near.

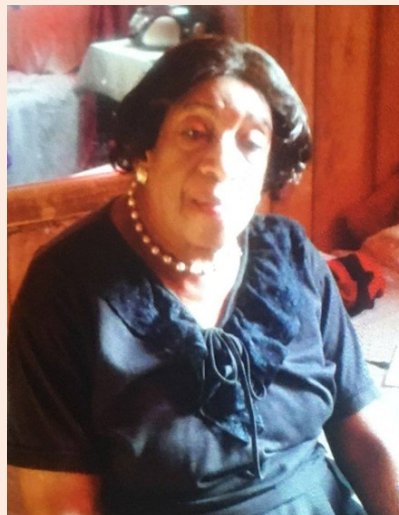
