Grandma is gone to Heaven

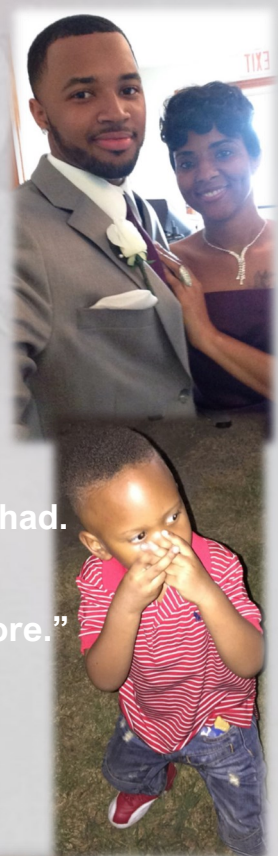
One quiet day the angels came and took grandma far away
