Nicy Mae Herron was born June 16, 1927 to the late Henry and Maria Woods. Nicy Mae departed this life June 5, 2021 in her home in Bolivar, Tennessee.

Nicy accepted Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior at an early age and joined Antioch Baptist Church in Whiteville, Tennessee under the leadership of Rev. Charles Murphy. She remained an active member until her death.
