But be thankful we had so many good years.

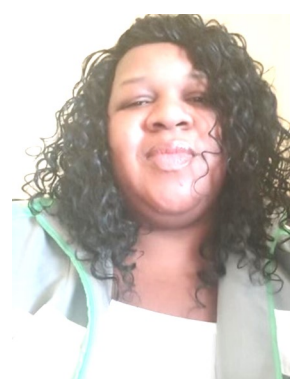
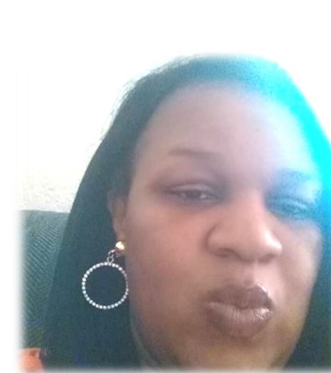
I gave you my love, and you can only guess

And if you need me, call and I will come.

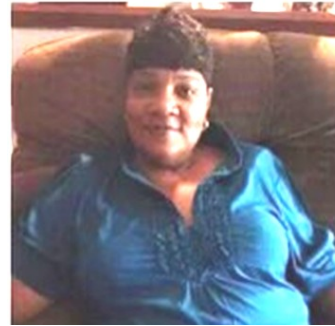
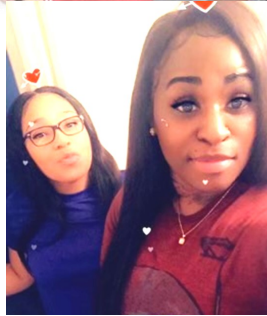
Though you can't see or touch me, I will be near.
