Cheryl Trangsrud, 77, Fargo, ND passed away on Friday, Nov. 18, 2022 at her home.

Cheryl Ann Goltz was born Oct. 19, 1945 in Fargo, ND to Allen and Clarice (Knutson) Goltz. She grew up at Leonard, ND and graduated from high school there in 1963. As a young girl, she started playing piano at churches in the area. Cheryl graduated from Humboldt Institute in Minneapolis, MN. She married Robert Kellerman in 1966. They raised two children, Ryan and Tanya and as a young family, they lived across the United States and always made a point to return to ND to visit and see family.
