Juanita Hodgson, 97, Fargo, ND, died on Saturday, March 18, at her home with family members at her side.

Juanita Violet Hodgson, one of nine children was born on January 1, 1926, to Russell and Olga Wilson in Arthur, ND. Juanita attended school in Arthur and graduated in 1943.
