

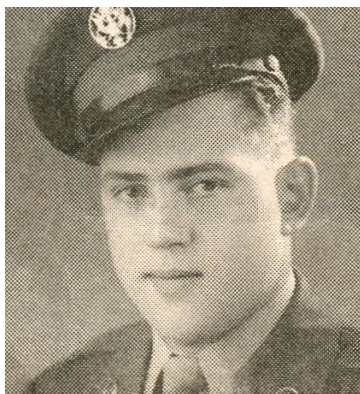
Remembering the life of....

Donald H. Mueller, 86, West Fargo, passed away Tuesday, January 10, 2017, at Sheyenne Crossings in West Fargo.

Donald Henry Mueller was born to Henry and Sophia Mueller on February 13, 1930 on a farm outside of Alice, ND. On January 14, 1949, he enlisted in the U.S. Air Force serving in Korea, Vietnam and numerous state side locations. Don retired from the Grand Forks Air Force Base as a Chief Master Sergeant in August of 1970 after 22 years of service to his country. Don married Vivian Frietag in May of 1949 and raised two sons during his time in the military. After leaving the Air Force, Don was employed from July 1971 to December of 1983 at the U.S. Postal Service in Moorhead, MN.
