

REMEMBERING THE LIFE OF...

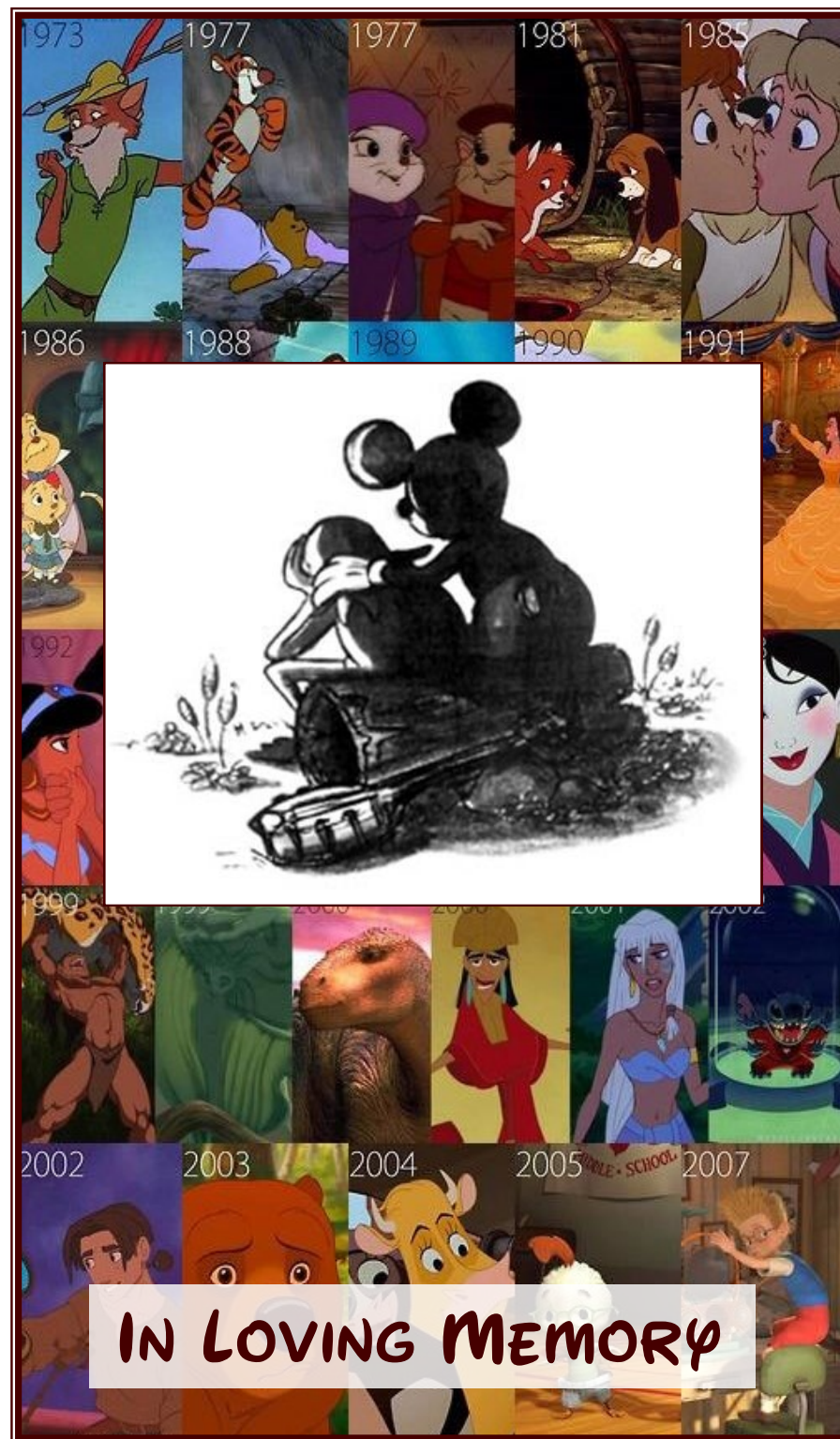
Chris Schmidt, 38, Fargo, ND died on Saturday, April 15, 2017 at his home.
