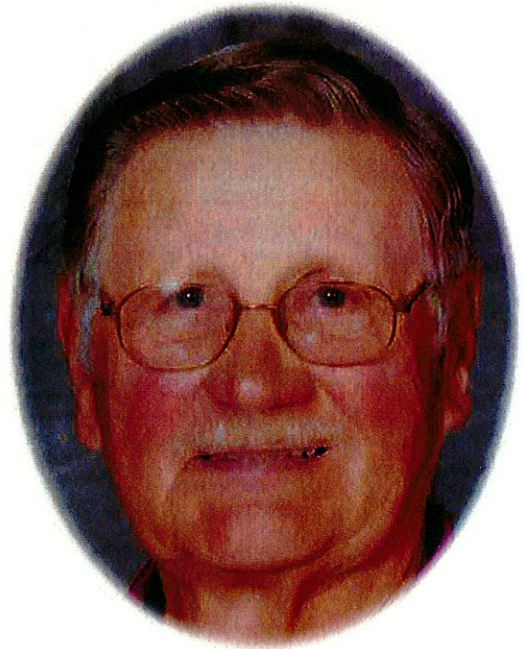




Fisherman's Prayer

Remembering the life of....

Ron G. Westrick, 79, Fargo, ND died on Friday July 21, 2017 at his lake home at Vergas, MN.

Ron was born on February 24, 1938 in Fargo, ND to John and Vivian (Ellingson) Westrick and grew up on a farm north of Fargo. He graduated from Fargo Central High School in 1955. He served for 24 years in the Air National Guard as a proud "Happy Hooligan" in the AGE Shop. He married Ruth Engh on December 9, 1961 in Jamestown, ND. They lived in Fargo where Ron worked at GM Parts Warehouse and Red Owl Warehouse before retiring on May 25, 1999 from his career as a UPS driver of 25 years.
