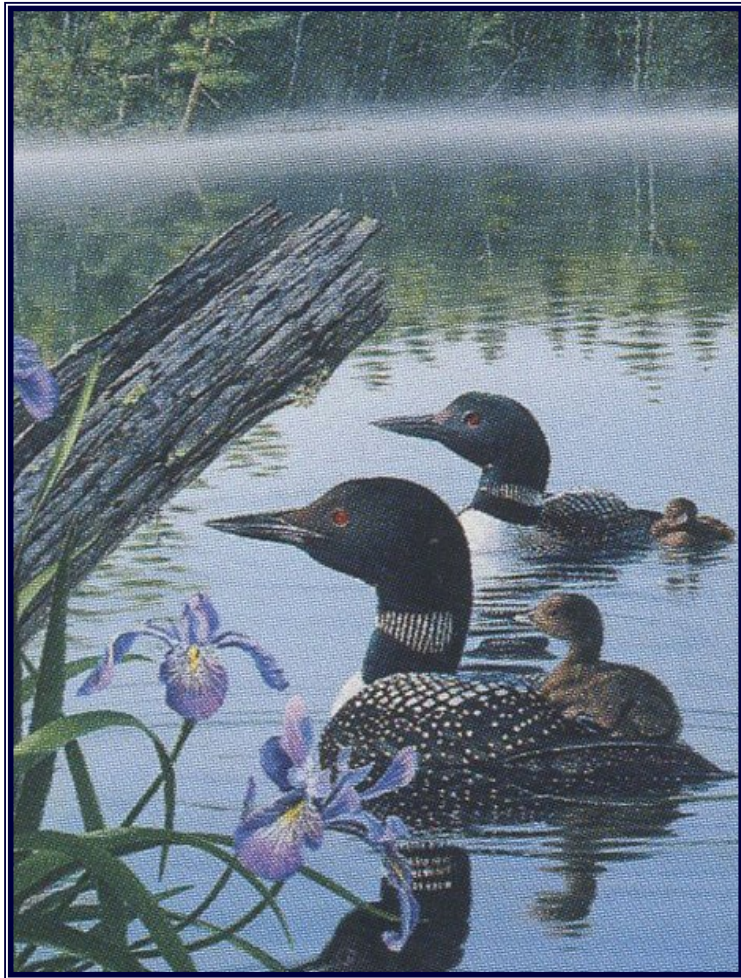
Marilyn Jean Harrold, 76, West Fargo, ND died Monday, July 31, 2017 at her home under the care of Hospice of the Red River Valley.

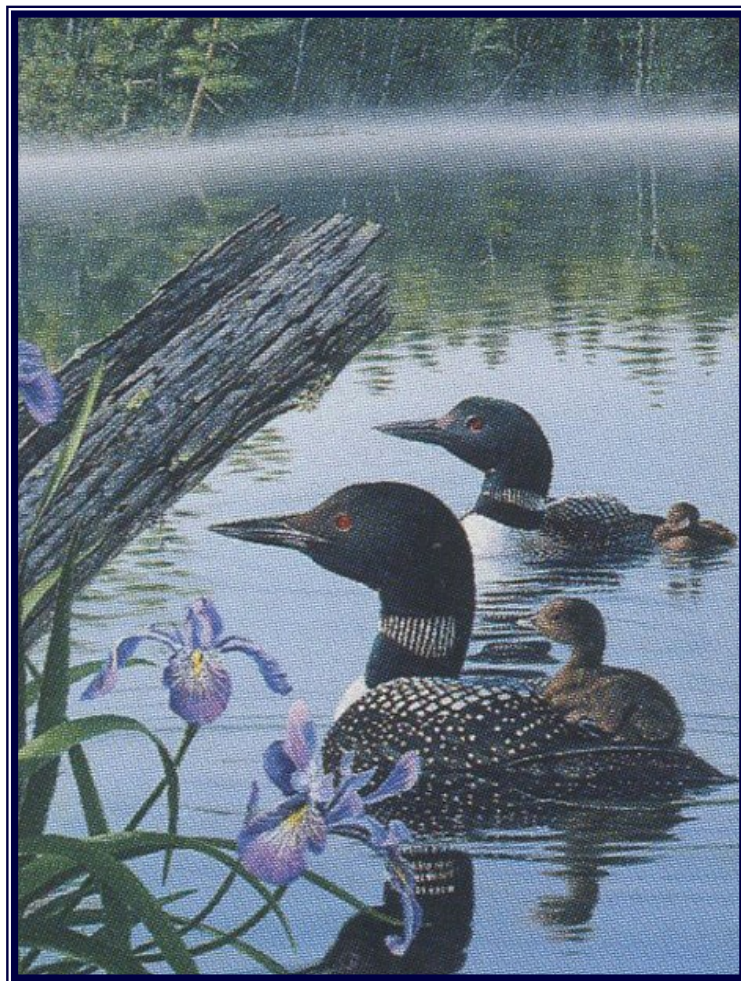
