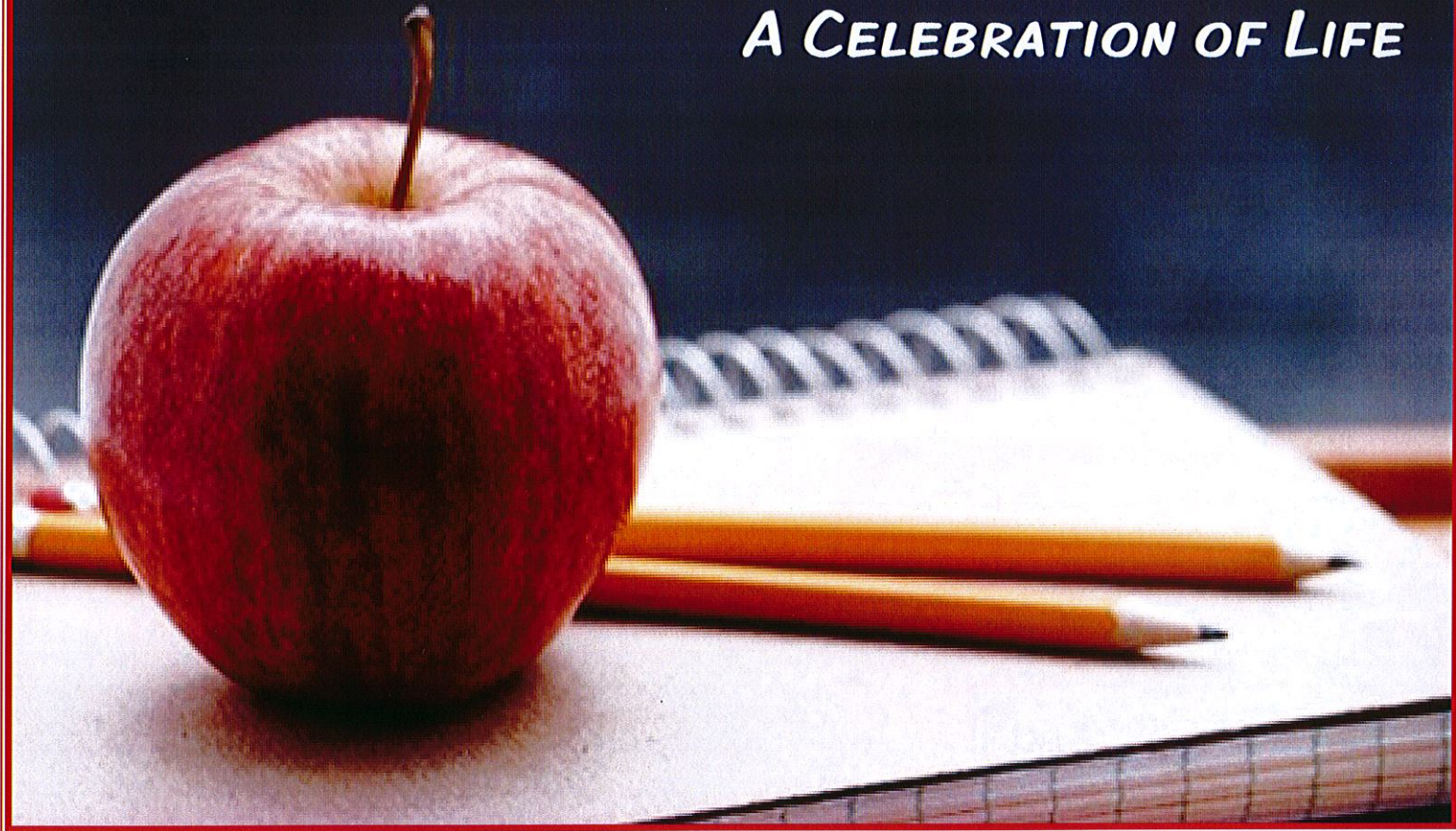

She graduated from Valley City State University in 1975 and earned a Master's Degree in Educational Technology from Leslie University in Boston, MA in 2010. She began her 42-year career in education teaching elementary education in Alexander, ND in 1975.
