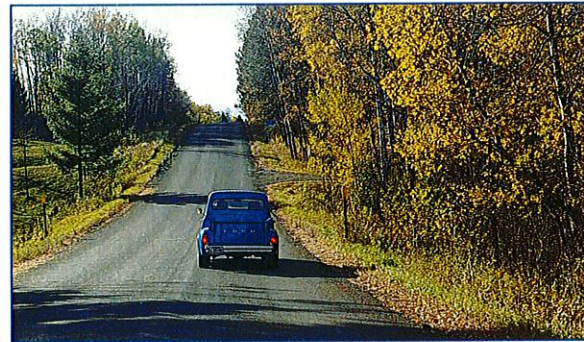
HOWARD SMEDSHAMMER
